





Nanxiang Steamed Bun Restaurant

Huabao Tower

No. 265, Middle Fangbang Road

The elegant and luxurious Huabao Tower was once the earliest antique market and the largest handicraft shopping mall in Shanghai. After being upgraded and renovated, it focuses on mid-to-high-end tea sets and tea culture with life aesthetics, and incorporates multiple business types, such as exhibition, literati gathering, auction and live broadcast.

Ancient Town Park

No. 333, Renmin Road

Located in the northeast corner of the Yuyuan Garden, this place was once the well-known "Danfeng Tower", which was a corner of the city wall of former Shanghai County and one of the "Eight Scenic Spots of Shanghai". The city wall was built in Shanghai to resist the invaders. After peace returned to the Old City, the nearby Danfeng Tower and some other buildings were moved onto the city wall for the people to pray and enjoy entertainment.

Dajing Pavilion

No. 259-269, Dajing Road

Located at the Small North Gate of the Old City, it is one of the two sections of the ancient city wall that have survived to this day in the Old City of Shanghai. The wall of Dajing Pavilion was originally an arrow platform, but was built into the Guan Yu Temple later. In the Qing Dynasty, this place was named Dajing after the inscription "Da Qian Sheng Jing (Great Scene of the World)". In the first year of the Republic of China era, the city wall hindered the development of the city's economy and transportation, and thus was demolished. But the Dajing Pavilion and a 50-meter-long section of the ancient wall beside it remained as the wall demolition command was located at the Dajing Pavilion.

Fudan University 18

Exit 1 of the station is the first station in Shanghai that extends into a campus. The interior of the station is dominated by bright red. The gray white walls are engraved with Fudan's motto, famous quotes and various works of art, highlighting the cultural heritage of the nationally renowned university.



Jing'an Temple

The Jing'an Temple Station adopts the elements of wooden pillars and stone pillar bases of the ancient Jing'an Temple for its station hall and platforms, so that passengers walking in the underground space can easily relate to the cityscape on the ground.



Wuzhong Road 15

Geometrically cut metal and LED lights create "an image of the city" as long as more than 70 meters in the station's curved hall, brimming with hi-tech features.



Changyi Road 14 18

As the route hosts quite some structures, such as a tunnel, a passageway and Metro Line 18, the station hall has to be supported by four pillars with a length and width of over two meters. Furthermore, the unique design of "fiery trees and silver flowers" is added to please the eye.



Site of the First CPC National Congress · South Huangpi Road 1 14

The design of the station is named "Shade of Huangpi", and the tree branch silhouette is inspired by the Chinese parasol tree. The design is in imitation of walking along some old streets in the shade of Chinese parasol trees in Shanghai.



Yuyuan Garden 14

Here, art is blended perfectly with light and shadows. Aluminum plates in different shapes are combined into "waves" of the Huangpu River. Curves, the other source of inspiration, create beautiful rhythms.



Changfeng Park 15

The name of this place comes from the poem "I will mount a long wind and break heavy waves", so the design of the station incorporates such elements as mountains, rivers and rocks.



Danyang Road 18

All elements in the station are covered in black and white, representing the "past" and "present" of Yangpu Riverfront. The dividing line in metallic color on the ground stands for a "timeline", marked with some historic sites and years.



Caoyang Road 14

Designed on the theme of "Working Class—A Backbone Force", the gate-like steel frames symbolize the spinning workshops, which are cradle of the workers' movement in western Shanghai. A large amount of white separated by some red demonstrates a texture of industrial aesthetics.



P Lujiazui 2 14

Outside the turnstiles in a passage close to Exit 1 and the Shanghai Tower, there is a curvy space where thick pillars support some white hollowed-out "mushroom clouds", exuding an ethereal vibe as if in the universe.







It focuses on presenting the historical evolution of modern Shanghai in the aspects of politics, economy, culture, society, life, etc.

The play mainly targets young audiences and combines the performance with river views. While watching the show and appreciating the scenery, audiences can take part in interesting evidence-collecting plot interactions and experience a fantastic journey through time and space.

The theatre is adapted from *The Solitary Gourmet*, a highly acclaimed IP work. For the first time, the concept of "dining in earnest" combined with the love as in *We Made a Beautiful Bouquet* is integrated into a theatric performance. During the play, the audience in each zone enjoys a different immersive dining experience in a Chinese restaurant built after the real scenes in Chinatown. Such a "small environmental theatre" is different from the traditional proscenium stage, and the space can be freely adjusted according to the content of the play. The combination of "performance + experience" allows both to be upgraded and updated continuously.



Shanghai Concert Hall

No. 523, East Yan'an Road, Huangpu District 🖟 1 🙎 8 People's Square 8 Dashijie

As China's first professional music performance venue, the concert hall was designed by Fan Wenzhao and Zhao Shen, two of the first group of Chinese architects who had studied abroad. It was completed in 1930 and renamed Shanghai Concert Hall in 1959. The concert hall is the center of song of the film. Shanghai's music activities and a cultural landmark of the city.



Shanghai Xin Guang Theatre

No. 586, Ningbo Road, Huangpu District 📮 🚹 🔼 8 People's Square 🔼 East Nanjing Road

Its predecessor is the Strand Theatre built in 1930. China's first sound film The Singing Peony starring Hu Die was released here. After Shanghai was liberated, the theatre had been dedicated to Shanghai Opera for a long time. It had been renamed several times and also served as a cinema. Its reconstruction was completed in 1994, turning it to the present Xin Guang Theatre.



Shanghai Tianchan **Yifu Theatre**

No. 701, Fuzhou Road, Huangpu District

People's Square

Founded in 1925 and formerly known as Tianchan Stage, it is the only theatre in Shanghai that stages Peking Opera mostly and is the oldest existing theatre in the city offering performances of traditional Chinese operas. It was once acclaimed as "the largest theatre in the Far East". People used to say, "A Peking Opera actor has to perform at Tianchan to become famous." In 2021, it returned with a new look.



Chang Jiang Theatre

9 4F, No. 35, Huanghe Road, Huangpu District People's Square

Formerly known as Carlton Theatre, founded in 1923 and designed by Laszlo Hudec, designer of Park Hotel, the theatre is an important drama performance venue in Shanghai. In 2018, it was rebuilt. Now it incorporates multiple functions, including carrying forward experience, educational promotion and cultural exchange.

Shanghai Grand Theatre

No. 300, Renmin Avenue, Huangpu District People's Square

It is the first modern theatre in China built as per the standards of international first-class theatres. The shape of "crystal palace" implies an ancient Chinese belief that "sky is round and earth is square". It has become a display platform for world-class artworks, a communication platform for international art activities and a promotion platform for public art education.



HuangPu Theatre

No. 780, East Beijing Road, Huangpu District

Its predecessor is the Lyric Theatre known as "a palace of Chinese films". It was in this old cinema that the film Children of Troubled Times (1935) was premiered and the Chinese anthem March of the Volunteers was first sounded as the theme



SAIC · Shanghai Culture Square

No. 597, Middle Fuxing Road, Huangpu District 🗒 1 10 12 South Shaanxi Road

The site of the square was originally the French-built "Canidrome", which was later rebuilt into the city's cultural square. It is a palace of art in the greenery and the world's largest underground theatre, equipped with high-tech, changeable and multi-functional stages, firstly in the country integrating the fountain and ice-making installations and high-tech means into the creation of musicals.



No. 1, South Xizang Road, Huangpu District

📮 8 14 Dashijie

Dashijie (Great World) built in 1917 used to be the largest amusement venue in the Far East. The renovated Dashijie offers visiting citizens and tourists richer cultural experiences. In the daytime, there are nostalgic traditional farce shows and shadow plays; in the evening, visitors can enjoy dramas, musicals and immersive game plays presented by Mahua Fun Age and other troupes.



Shanghai Gong Stage

No. 433, East Yan'an Road, Huangpu District 📮 🛭 🖊 Dashijie

As one of the four major Peking opera stages in Shanghai in the past, it was famous for presenting Shanghai-style Peking opera that features trick settings and long serial plays. Later, Gong Stage was renovated and reopened in 2010 as a permanent venue for the stage show *Era — Intersection of Time*.

Performing Spaces in Shopping Malls

There are over 100 theatres in Shanghai, and every one of them attracts fans of shows. Some of them are "hidden" in crowded shopping malls.

Shanghai Lyceum Theatre

No. 57, South Maoming Road, Huangpu District 🗐 🚺 10 12 South Shaanxi Road 13 Middle Huaihai Road

It is the first Western-style theatre built after Shanghai opened its port to foreign trade, originally owned by the Lyceum Theatre Custody Committee of a British amateur drama club in Shanghai. Since its removal

to the current building in 1931, it has remained in use.



The Great Theatre of China

No. 704, Niuzhuang Road, Huangpu District People's Square

It was one of the four major Peking Opera stages in Shanghai. In the 1940s, many Peking Opera masters including Mei Lanfang had graced the stage. In 1944, it was named The Great Theatre of China. In 2018, the theatre's renovation project was completed successfully.
