

Nanjing has the resilience of bamboo

The patient strength of water

And can be an emblem of modest rapture of the cherry blossom

Out of all the metaphors I can fathom, I would suggest that Nanjing at its core evokes the spirit of a firefly

The firefly has slender wings and can thrive in the twilight hours

The firefly reminds us of how nature can create such complex beauty and can form one of many uniquely mighty and mysterious beings

It is perhaps one of the oddest creatures, it is a soft bodied beetle that emits a warm yellow glow

Nanjing is a small firefly that provides a flicker of light into our understanding of existence through the sincere devotion to the past and powerful literary spaces

The city walls and cultural hubs are the soul and foundation of the people and have over the centuries helped us gracefully divulge into our own evanescence through the brevity of the arts and provenance of heritage that create tiny moments of satori

A firefly can shine light on the ocean of information, can fly through the stormy skies of knowledge and enlighten us on beauty that scholars cannot even unravel

We are like frogs, in the twilight hours, who gaze at the firefly's twinkle with bewilderment and wonder

This light gives us hope and guides us in our darkest hours



If you have the pleasure of visiting this city, it evokes the whispers of a firefly













In the unbearable high temperature and intense heat waves, we need to be close to water. We love to be near the water and fin a touch of coolness. Therefore, "Charming Jiangsu", with the river and sea embracing the world, the refreshing lake breeze, the chilling riverside, and cities filled with lively summer life, shows the coveted ecological beauty. ith the onset of the long-awaited summer, every person has the desire to take time off from everyday life, monotonous work and the hustle and bustle of the city. At this moment, it is best to put all business aside and go to a place where life is slow and unhurried, where all problems are forgotten and every day is like a great, never-ending vacation. One of these places is, of course, a secluded spot by the sea. Listening to the soothing sound of the surf, we can enjoy the incredibly beautiful sunrises, sunsets, and delicious seafood.

Along the about 1,000-km-long coastline in Jiangsu, many islets are scattered like pearls in the blue waters of the Yellow Sea (the Huanghai Sea), and the largest of them is the Liandao in Lianyungang.

Liandao is the largest islet in Jiangsu Province, which takes its

name from the intersection of the eastern and western islet group. Liandao borders the port of Lianyungang city. It has a coastline of 18 kilometers long and covers an area of 7.57 square kilometers. Most of the islet consists of picturesque forests and winding mountainous landscapes that offer majestic views of the sea.

In the center of the Liandao, there is a beautiful natural beach, Da Sha Wan Amusement Park, where adventure seekers can experience the speed of speedboats and motorboats, ride hovercraft or just play with the sea waves. Those who prefer a more relaxed pastime can enjoy the sea waves from the shore or even build a sand castle. After that, it is not superfluous to visit the fishing village and try the local cuisine, namely absolutely fresh seafood such as yellow croaker, prawn, pomfret, mackerel, oysters and mantis shrimp, as well as the local tea - Yunwu tea. This is also the production base of seaweed, and you can buy some seaweed as a souvenir.

In the evening, there is nothing more beautiful than a walk along the shore of a quiet harbor in the interior of the islet - Suma Bay. Here the sea merges with the sky and you can see peacocks circling in the air. A slow walk on the beach, a cool breeze, the gentle music of the surf... When you are tired, you can sit down on the warm sand and watch the fascinating sunset. All these create a cozy and calm atmosphere, helping you relax and get rid of the accumulated stress.

Once you visit this place, you will definitely want to return here again, together with your loved ones, to hide from the hustle and bustle of the world on a cool islet and realize your most beautiful dreams of a perfect vacation.


ome to watch migratory birds, gather seafood on the beach, and enjoy the beautiful UNESCO World Natural Heritage site! Tiaozini Wetland, located in the northeast corner of the coast of Dongtai City, Yancheng, is the first UNESCO World Natural Heritage site in Jiangsu Province and the 14th UNESCO World Natural Heritage site in China - a sub-area of China's Yellow (Bohai) Sea Migratory Bird Habitat (Phase I). It lies halfway along the East Asian-Australasian Flyway, one of the three major migration paths, also known as the "International Airport for Birds".

Tiaozini has a unique view of the sea, with flat beach, soft mud and a wide field of view. When the tide rises, it's a world of waters, and when the tide falls, it's a

wide expanse of flat land. It's not only rich in creatures and a good place to catch seafood, but also an ideal place to watch the sunrise and the changing tides.

Here, you can observe birds up close with the help of binoculars, watch the spectacle of tens of thousands of birds flying in Tiaozini Wetland, and appreciate the summer charm of the UNESCO World Natural Heritage site.

> Walking barefoot on the "sticky" beach after the tide recedes, or chasing the waves, or treading on clams and digging brackish-water crabs, you'll accidentally become covered in clay but reap a lot of happiness. You can also come to seafood restaurants in Tiaozini to try authentic local seafood such as clams, large razor clams, mud snails, pomfrets, etc., taste delicious coastal delicacies, and listen to the stories of coastal people on boats to fish.









SUNSET

on the Golden Beach in Nantong

Every person should go to the sea at least once in his or her life, feeling the sea air, listening to the sound of the surf, and enjoying the beautiful sunset... For this you do not have to buy plane tickets to fly to other countries and carry a heavy suitcase everywhere. Sometimes the most magical places are much closer than we think. We are talking about the beautiful port city of Nantong in Jiangsu, namely the famous Golden Beach of "Qidong Round Horn".





"Qidong Round Horn" borders the Yellow Sea in the east and the Yangtze River in the south. The Yangtze River, the East China Sea and the Yellow Sea meet here. The muddy river water and the azure sea water are clearly distinguished, and these three waters are inextricably intertwined, making it a unique landscape.

At this place you can also see the huge statue of Da Yu, a legendary Chinese hero who tamed the Yellow River, and Yinyang building. If you climb the building, you can see the beautiful sunrise, which occurs here earlier than other places in Jiangsu Province.

The Golden Beach is located in the east of "Qidong Round Horn". It gets its name from the amazing visual effect that can be seen here every summer evening. During sunset, the rays of the setting sun illuminate the seashore, giving the appearance of gold dust being scattered on the shore - the sand on the shore glows with a ray of golden sunlight, as if it was made of real gold. This unforgettable sight will remain in the memory of every


eyewitness for a long time.

The low tide and high tide area on the beach is quite large, so everyone has the opportunity to ride an all-terrain vehicle (ATV) over the sand at low tide and ride through the waves of the sea at high tide together with a professional trainer. In the evening, after low tide, you can ride an ox cart, or just walk along the endless beach with friends, looking for crabs, mud snails and clams, playing and enjoying this "beach party".

The sea air clears your mind, the hustle and bustle of everyday life is far away, the wind caresses your face, and the waves are always happy to walk with you on the soft sand. And in the evening, watching the sunset by the sea and then admiring the stars, you will feel how beautiful and infinite our world is, and what happiness you live here and now.

In these places, you can have a good time, rest your body and mind,







Intimate to water by the Grand Canal bank

The Grand Canal flows leisurely on the land of Jiangsu, nourishing cities along its banks. It also brings people bursts of coolness that is exclusive to summer.

The Qingjiangpu Scenic Area of Huai'an Li Canal Cultural Corridor, taking Li Canal as an axis, has a diversified culture including

canal, opera, celebrities, couplets and so on. On the south bank are Guoshi Pagoda, Chen and Pan Memorial Temple, Ciyun Temple, etc. On the north bank are the former residences of famous people, Huai'an Shuilong Bureau, Water Ferry, etc.

To appreciate the beauty of Qingjiangpu, rafting on the Li Canal is an excellent choice. The pavilions and pagodas on both sides of the canal reflect each other among the rippling canal where wild ducks are cruising. The night is even more enchanting and colorful with bright lights and shadows. On both sides of the road, neon flashes under stars dotted in the sky. Take a cruise on a gaily painted boat, admire the illuminated houses on both sides of the canal, listen to the murmur of the water, and you're tracing the prosperous scenery of the former water transportation center.

20 km from Huaian East Railway Station, 30 minutes' drive The east side of the Grand Canal is connected to Luoma Lake at Suqian. On the east bank of Luoma Lake, the rippling blue water, fine white sand, swaying cattails and tall palm trees enhance each other's beauty, making people feel like they are on a tropical beach. Luoma Lake Beach Park consists of three areas: leisure beach, sports beach and water bay beach, which organically integrate lake sightseeing, water sports and beach entertainment.

At the lakeside bathing beach, you can rent a speedboat to experience the thrill of riding the wind and waves of the big lake. Wherever the speedboat goes, layers of waves are stirred up. When the cool breeze blows your face, the heat is gone! Every summer, the International Sand Sculpture Festival is held here. Lifelike sand sculptures of different shapes stand on the beach. This year, the 4th International Sand Sculpture Festival in Luoma Lake will last until October, with the theme of "Animation Carnival", giving sand sculptures new vitality.

In addition to playing, by walking barefoot on the soft white sand and listening to the lake water lapping the shore, you can feel the beauty of nature to the fullest; or you can comfortably sit on a beach chair in a thatched hut and take a nap, enjoying the soothing lake breeze. You can also drive 30 minutes to the Dongguankou Historical and Cultural Park in the southeast of Suqian City. The water area here is about 22,600 square meters. The ancient city wall, old wharf, old market and other buildings are artistically reproduced, showing the prosperity of the ancient charm of Dongguan in the past. On the majestic tower, you can overlook the Grand Canal and have a panoramic view of the waterfront.

n the banks of Hongze Lake, the fourth largest freshwater lake in China, there is Hongze Lake Ancient Weir Scenic Area in Huai'an, which is a complex ecological and cultural tourism scenic spot integrating cultural experience, health care and leisure, lake sightseeing, and forest exploration.

With a history of over 1,800 years, Hongze Lake Levee is a world cultural heritage site and a key historical and cultural site under state protection, including multiple historical sites along such as Emperor Qianlong's Imperial Stele, Zhouqiao Big Pond and Xinba Dam Site etc. It is the Great Wall on the water and a "natural oxygen bar". Walking along the embankment while breathing the fresh air and feeling the cool lake breeze of Hongze Lake is comfortable and cozy.

Water Kettle Town in the scenic area covers an area of 755 mu (50.3 hectares). Its architectural style is dominated by imitating the Song Dynasty style gardens, pavilions, terraces and buildings alternating with each other, small bridges and the floating rivers reflecting each other. The exquisite and particular buildings and limpid, clear river water have drawn a modern version "Riverside Scene at Tomb-sweeping Day", a masterpiece by Zhang Zeduan from the Song Dynasty. Everything you expect in "Jiangnan", or the area south of the down-

stream Yangtze River, is all here.

The Fisherman Bay is sparkling and graceful, sometimes calm with the water and the sky merging in one color, and sometimes turbulent with waves surging and crashing on the shore. There is also a beach that children love. If you have enough time, you can wait for the sunset here. The scenery where the water and the sky are connected is particularly spectacular, and every shot is scenery.







In hot summer, the Hongze Lake has a vast expanse of water. In addition to the Hongze Lake Levee and the lakeside bathing beach, the Happiness Park is also a good place to escape the summer. The Ancient Weir Scenic Area is very close to the urban area of Hongze, and it is very convenient to go to the surrounding area to eat after playing. You can taste the authentic lake delicacies in any restaurant.

The metasequoia forest is a paradise for wild animals. Great bustards, white storks, black storks, gray herons, and egrets like to nest and live here the most.

If you are looking for more joy by water, the Sihong Hongze Lake Wetland Scenic Area in Suqian City is recommended. Floating a boat in the reed maze, you can enjoy the beautiful scenery among bends of the waterway where reeds are like green gauze tents, listen to the joyful chants of water birds, feel the refreshing lake breeze, and appreciate the purity of the "ecological oxygen bar".

Go sightseeing on the Bailu Lake, you can see the vast expanse of green waves and boundless smoggy water in the distance and the field of lotus leaves close by. Flocks of egrets either stand overlooking, or walk on the dam, or fish in the lake. Visiting here, you'll have a poetic feeling just like "floating on green waves and rambling in a painting".

A 30-minute drive can also take you to Mudun Island in Suqian to participate in the annual Hongze Lake Lotus Festival, where you can watch the delightful lotus of thousands of acres sway.





Turtle Head Isle of Taihu Lake in Wuxi, famous for its spring cherry blossoms, is also suitable for summer visits, whose iris ensata in summer is also a must-see.

aihu Lake is beautiful, and its most charming part is in Wuzhong. Wuzhong District owns 80% of the Taihu Lake. Many scenic spots are scattered along the nearly 180-km-long Taihu Lake shoreline, with stunning views.

The 186.7-km-long No. 1 Highway around the Taihu Lake links many scenic spots along the lake. The scenery along the route is excellent with many cultural relics and historical sites, and abundant natural resources, which is a must-see of the Taihu Lake.

It is not too hot in early morning or at dusk in summer, and you can start your cycling trip from the Dongshan Visitor Center and ride along the "Taihu Blue" and "Binhu Red" of the No. 1 Highway around the Taihu Lake. The scenery is picturesque along the way. You can breathe fresh air in green mountains and forests and feel the cool breeze kissing your face. One side is the endless Taihu

Lake, and the other side are patchwork of quaint villages - the scenery will be engraved on your mind while you're riding. You can ride all the way to the Daixinwan Bridge to take refreshing and artistic photos, which is also a must-go place for many young people.

Turtle Head Isle in Binhu District of Wuxi occupies the most beautiful corner of the Taihu Lake. Looking into the south, it resembles the seaside of the coastal resort city of Qingdao; and looking into the north, it has the similar scenery of the West Lake in Hangzhou. Surrounded by the green lake, under the heavy shadows of the mountains, and in front of the iris ensata, you would suddenly feel like being in an old painting and that the time is quiet and leisurely pleasant. Before and after the Dragon Boat Festival, Taihu residents like to hang calamus to celebrate the festival, which is intended to ward off evil spirits and disease.

A stiff breeze on the mighty Yangtze River is a perfect way of keeping cool in this summer. To immerse yourself in the charm of the Yangtze River, it's worth experiencing the river cruise "Yangtze River Legend".

Visitors can take this cruise to see more than 10 famous cultural and natural attractions along the river, including Muyan Riverside Scenic Area, Nanjing Yangtze River Bridge, Zhongshan Wharf, Pukou Wharf, Yuejiang Tower, Yanziji Park and Baguazhou. And if you are lucky enough, you can also see Yangtze finless porpoise swimming in waves. With a total distance of about 27 kilometers and about 2 hours of sailing, the tour offers an in-depth look at the natural scenery, historical and cultural landscape and the charm of the Nanjing section of the Yangtze River.

The spiral stairs on the "Yangtze River Legend" cruise remind tourists of the movie Titanic starring Leonardo DiCaprio and Kate Winslet. Once off land, you can find yourself at the foot of the spiral stairs. But it only takes you just a split second to realize again that this is in China and everything needs to be as good as it gets.

In retrospect, those steps are also a glimpse of things to come; that you're in for a really rather special experience.

Starting from the Wumadu Cruise Terminal on Yongji Avenue, the cruise has been put into use for many years. Over one year ago, the "Yangtze River Legend" cruise entered service after being upgraded as a luxury liner.

The "Yangtze River Trip" sets off by sailing













a few kilometers downstream, passing Muyan Riverside Scenic Area (affording a great view of the Bodhidharma caves) and Yanziji, before turning around near the Nanjing Baguazhou Yangtze River Bridge (formerly the NO. 2 Nanjing Yangtze River Bridge).

Then it's on to the highlight of the cruise; the Nanjing Yangtze River Bridge. And top of the bucket list for all on board is a pic of themselves in front of the first bridge spanning the Yangtze River built without foreign help. It's hard not to be touched when tourists are rushing to take photos. On a more practical level, the detail discernible on the bridge's substructure can be viewed from the cruise, which will be a delight to any civil engineer, while nice touches are also afforded by the sign informing captains to "obey the law of the sea".

As the bridge recedes, we come upon Pukou Wharf and Pukou Railway Station, before once again turning around. According to the guide, Pukou Railway Station was the place where well-known Chinese scholar Zhu Ziqing was inspired to write the rem-

iniscence essay Retreating Figure. It's also the place where The Story of a Noble Family, the Chinese television series based on famous Chinese novelist Zhang Henshui's novel was filmed. Back on the right, going downstream again offers excellent views of Zhongshan Wharf that was completed in 1928. And there is also the former Nanjing Train Ferry Loading Trestle, built in 1933, which was the first railway train ferry line in China to ferry trains on giant wheels laid on rails, thus opening a direct railway line from Shanghai to Beijing.

Not long after we come upon a new sightseeing bridge right beside the Nanjing Yangtze River Bridge. Looking far away, the transparent ring-shaped bridge looks like a shining pearl necklace for the south fort of the bridge.

The bridge with a central glass deck is part of a 1.1-km-long extension to the Binjiang Greenway, which has finished its construction. From the bridge to the Nanjing Yuzui Wetland Park in the south, now a total of 21 kilometers of riverside walk for running and biking.

Then we're back under the Nanjing Yangtze River Bridge. On our way back, we can see the Yangtze finless porpoise observation point, Nanjing Green Exposition Park and Nanjing Jinling Shipyard. Although we didn't have the chance to witness the Yangtze finless porpoise, known as the "giant panda in water", leaping out of the river, the "Yangtze River Legend" cruise still brings visitors a wonderful trip. It may be one of the most enjoyable afternoons you have spent in Nanjing.

The Magpie Bridge Festival in July, the lanterns in August, and the melody heard in a boat with an unobstructed view of the Yanhe River are waiting for you.







To experience Changzhou's night, the Qingguo Lane located in the most prosperous section of the Grand Canal in Changzhou CANNOT BE MISSED.

t has numerous boats vying with each other and countless businessmen and guests swarming. For thousands of years, Qingguo Lane has resided in the city snuggling the Grand Canal. The river, interdependent with the houses along the river, the streets of the block, the former residence of celebrities, and majestic mansions, integrate the ancient beauty of the Grand Canal with modern style of a new Changzhou.

China Dinosaur Land, Dino Water Town, and Dinoman Club, whose gorgeous lights brighten the night sky of Changzhou. The implementation of the music festival, the sports festival, the tent film festival, and the intangible cultural heritage exhibition has made Changzhou Global Dinosaur Town a place that children are longing to go in the summer vacation

Among them, China Dinosaur Land holds different activities such as the exciting night tour, cool night show, and bright cruise every summer. hen the heavy traffic and riot of sounds in the daytime fade, the bright lanterns on the shore of Jinji Lake in Suzhou are lit up at night. On a cool summer night, the scenery on the smoggy and immense Jinji Lake completely unveils the "ancient charm and modern style" of the water town Gusu. 7.4 square kilometers of waters adds radiance to the garden and the water village, which is the most fashionable and vibrant side of Suzhou tourism, just like "double-sided embroidery" integrating both ancient charm and modern style.

Be it on a boat or on foot along the lake,

or boarding the ferris wheel to have a night view of Jinji Lake, the bright lights are as brilliant as the Milky Way, applying colors to the surface of the Jinji Lake, which is extremely gorgeous. Thousands of lights around the surrounding areas flicker like stars. The buildings are decorated with neon lights that are particularly eye-catching, spectacular and dazzling. The 14-km-long footpath around Jinji Lake connects Suzhou's iconic building "Gate of the Orient" the finishing touch of Suzhou's night view "Music Fountain", and Jinji Lake light show and other scenes. The colorful lights outline the unique shape of buildings, and decorate the Ligongdi Causeway, rendering it a gorgeous rainbow on Jinji Lake. The Moon Harbor and Taohua Island in the lake center is also particularly beautiful at night.

You can read or shop at Eslite Bookstore, watch operas at Suzhou Culture and Arts Center, and listen to Kunqu Opera in Suzhou Garden at night... At Jinji Lake, the most beautiful "urban living room" of Suzhou, culture and tourism are deeply integrated, the night economic pattern is complete, and cultural scenarios are rich, depicting a prosperous night picture of Suzhou that's most international, fashionable, and modern.

As an important part of Suzhou gardens, some of which serving as UNESCO world heritage sites, the waters around the Surging Wave Pavilion are equipped with a light belt for night sightseeing. Whenever night falls, along the Renmin Road by the Surging Wave Pavilion, and through Yinxi Bridge to Dayun Bridge, the warm orange lights are orderly lit up. In the garden, the immersive garden version of Kunqu Opera Six Chapters of a Floating Life kicks off at night. When the melody and soft Suzhou dialect encounter greenery shadows, it perfectly recovers the enjoyment of Kunqu Opera in the garden of distinguished families in "Jiangnan", or

the area south of the downstream Yangtze River in ancient times. It should be reminded that the night performance time needs to be confirmed in advance with the scenic area.

As one of the four famous gardens in Suzhou, the Master-of-Nets Garden is the first tourist attraction in Jiangsu and even the whole country to open and launch night tour products, which often hosts night garden performances. Kunqu Opera, Pingtan, Guqin, traditional stringed and woodwind music, classical dance and other art performances with Suzhou characteristics come out in turn. The garden and the song are combined into one, and being in it is like traveling through time and space.

uxi, located on the junction of the Yangtze River and the sea, borders the Taihu Lake. It is a famous historical and cultural city cultivated by the Grand Canal which not only passes through the city in Wuxi, but also passes around it, shaping the old city of Wuxi into a turtle shell and creating the historical districts of Beitang Street outside the north gate and Qingming Bridge Historical Culture Block outside the south gate. The Qingming Bridge Historical Culture Block, rooted on the banks of

the Wuxi section of the Grand Canal and located at the southern end of Wuxi City, takes the canal as the center axis and Qingming

Bridge as the core, preserving the original ecological features and the living habits and customs inherited from generation to generation. With the ancient river, bridge, street, kiln and temple adding radiance to each other, the block is known as "the open-air museum by the canal".

The section extending from Kuatang Bridge to Qingming Bridge of

the ancient canal is 1.5 kilometers long and about 20 meters wide, dotted by historical relics and human landscapes along the bank. You can feel the night breeze, stroll on the stone road of the Qingming Bridge Historical Culture Block, watch the canal water connecting the ancient bridges, and visit the Chinese Silk Industry Museum, the ancient kiln group site, the traditional opera pier, and the former residence of celebrities... These long corridors along the water and carved windows are all telling the charm of "Jiangnan", or the area south of the downstream Yangtze River.

The many elements in this area such as the temples, towers, pagodas, rivers, streets, bridges, kilns, houses and workshops are as intoxicating as in *Riverside Scene at Qingming Festival*, a masterpiece by Zhang Zeduan from the Song Dynasty.

Night experience consumption products of cultural tourism such as immersive performing arts, intangible cultural heritage interaction, and 3D light show make the night of the Qingming Bridge Historical Culture Block even more beautiful and lively. In the block, Wuxi "Jinye Liangxiao" Night Market is built, which includes the canal night banquet, Qingchuang fair, dynamic stage, special lanterns, and mobile floats, forming a colorful life of the night market.

A 600-YEAR-OLD GARDEN AND A 1800-YEAR-OLD AVENUE

Zhan Garden is one of the "Four Famous Gardens in Jiangnan" and is the best-preserved classical garden complex of the Ming Dynasty in Nanjing. In Zhan Garden, which has a history of more than 600 years, there is the Taiping Heavenly Kingdom History Museum.

It is worth mentioning that Zhan Garden is the location where the Grand View Garden in the TV series A Dream of Red Mansions (1987 version) and the Bai Mansion in the TV series The New Legend of White Snake (1992 version starring Zhao Yazhi) were filmed. Wang Fulin and Xia Zuhui, the directors of these two TV series, were both born in Jiangsu. Many classic TV series were filmed here, which is enough to see the exquisite classicism of Zhan Garden.

You can enter the garden at 17:00 for the night tour when it's not dark. The breeze blows when you stroll through the corridor under the rosy glow of sunlight, and the

light and shadow in Zhan Garden are intertwined. On the Ma Tau walls, there are oleanders, trumpet creepers, hypericum, and pomegranate flowers. In the courtyard, with the

window under the banana leaves, the roof made of green tiles, the water of a ravine stream and the wind breezing through the pine trees, every frame is full of the fresh beauty of "Jiangnan". The courtyard is filled with Chinese parasols, hackberries, camphor trees, osmanthus, michelia trees, willows, etc. When encountering the hydrangea blooming in front of the western rockery among the flowers and trees, it is an unforgettable beauty for more than 600 years that haunts my heart.

Zhan Garden is a riot of colors during daytime and is poetic and picturesque at night. When night falls and lights are on, the shadows under moonlight dance with

your dress, and the quaint pavilions and pagodas in Zhan Garden become resplendent under the neon light. The lights are changing, the lake is vast, the ancient music is echoing, and among the ships and pavilions, the talented and beautiful ladies walk with the music, just like in a dream.

Little Sister Lin Falls down from the Heaven, The Peony Pavilion, The Butterfly Lovers... the immersive live-action opera performance starts at 18:30. A romantic piece of Kungu Opera, a scene of "A Dream of Red Mansions" in the Yueju Opera, and the vast expanse of water under the misty halo render the scenery of Zhan Garden all the more touching.

It should be remembered that the immersive live-action opera performance is held every Saturday night and may be

suspended due to weather and other factors. Please refer to the announcement of the scenic area. Don't forget to

bring mosquito repellents. The luxuriance of plants in this "No. 1 Jinling" will surprise you.



THE POWER OF MUSEUMS

Earlier this summer, International Museum Day was held. The International Council of Museums has announced its 2022 theme: *The Power of Museums*. On the occasion of the 46th International Museum Day, TravelGo, a Chinese travel service platform, released the "Top 10 Most Popular Museums for Travelers in China in the First Half of 2022". Nanjing Museum and Nanjing Imperial Examination Museum of China, also known as Jiangnan Imperial Examination Hall, were included in the list.

Museums in the 21st century, on top of making the world a better place, have enormous potential and influence to enrich summer life. Coinciding with the summer vacation, the museums have become a good place for students to study. Science and technology museums, memorial halls, art galleries, public cultural spaces... Entering the research and study spaces shared by the host and guests all over Jiangsu, you'll find they all have humanistic concern, aesthetic taste and cultural connotation. Whether it's watching plays or exhibitions, reading or watching movies, learning knowledge, entertainment, or immersive experience, research spaces with both

"beauty" and "connotation" everywhere have not only become a new landmark of Jiangsu's cultural and tourism integration, but also nurtured the minds of students with the thousand-year-old cultural heritage.

The sounds of the wind, of the rain, and of reading aloud all come to my ears; the affairs of the family, of the state and of the world are all my concerns... This couplet hanged more than 400 years ago by the Donglin Academy in Wuxi, a famous academy in China, demonstrates the earnest expectations for young people from ancient times to the present. In the Wuxi public cultural space, the Donglin Academy's "Academy Life Culture and Tourism Experience Center", which carries Donglin Academy's style of study for a thousand years and the vitality of the times, has

opened new learning activities such as research camps and traditional art training during the summer vacation. It also regularly conducts performances of Guqin, Kunqu Opera, Xiju Opera, Pingtan, and folk music, attracting many students wearing traditional Chinese costumes to come and taste special cakes and attend tea parties of the culture of Number One Scholar "Zhuangyuan", which means the exam's highest scorer.

During the summer holidays, we will also celebrate China's 17th Cultural and Natural Heritage Day. China boasts 42 intangible cultural heritage items on the UNESCO's Lists of Intangible Cultural Heritage as of December 2020, ranking first in the world. Data from TravelGo shows that by the end of May 2022, the number of searches for

tourism related to cultural heritages has increased by 127% year on year. In the whole country, it is people in Jiangsu province that pay the most attention to cultural heritage tourism. The intangible cultural heritage is the cultural code shared by every Chinese person. They are not displayed on shelves or frozen in Chinese characters, but are vividly integrated into our lives. We invite foreign college students from all over Jiangsu to visit the Chinese Imperial Examination Museum and other good places for research and study, to experience Fu Baoshi's style, Lin Sanzhi's manner, and Yan Wenliang's charm, and to have education tourism in summer, self-improvement and self-cultivation that's the same as thousands of years ago.

Interestingly, every year the second day of the International Museum Day is China Tourism Day, and China Tourism Day has a long history with Jiangsu.

In the 1608, 22-year-old Xu Xiake decided to take a trip without plan. He set out from his hometown of Jiangyin, Jiangsu province. After more than 30 years, he traveled most of China. He wrote a 600,000-word of The Travels of Xu Xiake, and he was called "The Chinese Traveling Saint". More than 400 years later, Ma Shaoqin, a native of Ninghai, Zhejiang province, called for the establishment of "China Tourism Day" and it was dated at May 19, which was the opening day of Diary of a Visit to Tiantai Mountain, the first chapter of The Travels of Xu Xiake. After the adoption of the resolution, every year on May 19 is "China Tourism Day" since 2011. On the occasion of this ancient day of fun brought by the 400-year-old KOL in the field of tourism, the charming Jiangsu with more than 300 registered museums, sincerely invites you to visit.

A Painter's Former Residence Near Century-Old Academies

Fu Baoshi Memorial Hall is located in his former residence at NO. 132 Hankou Xi Road in Nanjing, very close to Hohai University and Nanjing Normal University. It was created to collect and preserve the paintings and relics of China's most renowned contemporary masters Fu Baoshi, and to show them to the world. The memorial hall covers an area of 3,000m² and has eight unique exhibition halls where the life of Fu Baoshi is introduced. In the memorial hall are great works of paintings, research carried out by the author, and even some of the painter's thoughts embodied in books of the time. Fu Baoshi Memorial Hall is a small place but rich in artistic and academic content.

Fu Baoshi is one of the most influential artists of modern China, from Xinyu, Jiangxi Province. Among his achievements is the revolution of Chinese ink painting, employing a new technique in his works through the use of dots and ink methods. which were different from the traditional

standards of that time. He went to Japan to study the History of Oriental Art in the Tokyo School of Fine Arts. After returning to China, he worked in the National Central University and Nanjing Normal University. Fu Baoshi was also the director of the Jiangsu Traditional Chinese Painting Institute and the vice chairman of the Chinese Artist Federation.

An ancient but elegant style with a poetic atmosphere and new painting techniques represent Fu Baoshi's works. His feelings towards the land of China are also strongly recognizable, as the splendor of rivers and mountains inspired by nature are present in most of his paintings, making him the representative landscape painter of his time. In addition to landscape painting, Fu Baoshi was also inclined toward figure painting. His paintings became so well known that he was even considered more advanced than most of his contemporaries for his innovative brushwork and unique image composition.

Among many of the fine art theses by Fu Baoshi, he analyzed the evolution of Chinese painting and consequently thoroughly investigated the history of landscape painting in past centuries, including works by other renowned Chinese great painters. Fu Baoshi sought to equal the greatness in his works of painters from different eras, such as the Yuan Dynasty and the Ming Dynasty, among others, until he finally became one of the master painters of his time.

In Ecuador, the South American country I come from, there were also great painters comparable to Fu Baoshi. Ecuadorian painters developed a wide variety of styles ranging from religious pieces to landscapes and abstract paintings that allow us to admire the art history of an area rich in resources and culture. In contrast to the works of Fu Baoshi, Oswaldo Guayasamín, known to be one of the most important Ecuadorian painters of the 20th century, focused his works on poverty. He was an avid supporter of indigenous people.


Mr. Lin Sanzhi was born in Nanjing, Jiangsu Province in 1898. He is a master of poetry, calligraphy and painting in modern China, and is known for "three wonders". His bold and unrestrained "San Style" cursive script is particularly beyond comparison today, winning him the name of "Sage of Cursive Calligraphy".

Oiuvu Mountain Cultural Park in

Pukou District, Nanjing, used to be a place where ancient people set up altars to pray for rain. The grass and trees here reveal the ancient charm of immortality. Today, it brings together the memorial halls of Lin Sanzhi, Hu Xiaoshi, Gao Ershi, and Xiao Xian, the four contemporary calligraphers, and tens of thousands of precious calligraphy and paintings in the collection. Each brick and tile carries a strong cultural atmosphere.

Among them, the Lin Sanzhi Memorial Hall was built by the mountain, with the garden-style buildings of Ming and Qing dynasties hidden on the sunny slope in green pines and cypresses. The main exhibition buildings in the hall are the Sanmu Mountain House, the Stele Gallery, and the Qiuyu Mountain Painting and Calligraphy Institute. The museum has more than 500 paintings and calligraphy works by Mr. Lin Sanzhi.

It takes 45 minutes to drive from Qiuyu Mountain Cultural Park to Pukou Caosheng Shuxiang Cultural Park, where calligraphy culture is the core to build a cultural exchange base, including Lin Sanzhi Art Exchange Center, Lin Sanzhi's former residence "House of Three Obsessions" and other places. In addition, you can also visit Lingongdi at night to appreciate the calligraphy culture and artistic style.

here is an old ancient Greek style building by the Surging Wave Pavilion in Suzhou with twelve quite distinctive Roman columns in front of the corridor. Here, you can talk to the literati garden in "Jiangnan", or the area south of the downstream Yangtze River. It used to be the site of Suzhou Art Academy, one of the cradles of modern art education in China. The main building is the Greekstyle teaching building built by Mr. Yan Wenliang, commonly known as the "Roman Building".

The founder of the art academy, Yan Wenliang, has cultivated a large number of artistic talents. Along with Xu Beihong, Lin Fengmian, and Liu Haisu, he is listed as the "Four Founders" of China's modern art education. He established China's first art museum, the Suzhou Art Museum, which has been here for over a century.

After renovations in recent years, the Yan Wenliang Memorial Hall has been connected to the Surging Wave Pavilion, a UNESCO World Heritage site and the oldest existing garden in Suzhou. The memorial hall specially restores the classrooms, school flags, school emblems, school journals and other physical materials used by Suzhou Art Academy. Here, you can also watch interviews with old alumni of Suzhou Art Academy. In addition, exhibitions of Yan Wenliang and Suzhou Art Academy are held all year round.

From Yan Wenliang Memorial Hall, it takes a 30 minutes' walk to Wu Zuoren Art Museum, which is located near the Twin Towers, a famous ancient architectural attraction in Suzhou, and not far from Suzhou Pingjiang Historic Block.

Wu Zuoren is another leading figure in the Chinese art community after Xu Beihong, and is an outstanding contemporary Chinese painter. With a style of his own, he has deep attainments in sketching, oil painting, and art education, and in the creation of Chinese painting.

After the renovation, Wu Zuoren Art Museum has successively launched exhibitions such as "Research Exhibition of Wu

Zuoren and Xiao Shufang's 'Foziling Reservoir'" and "Research Exhibition of Wu Zuoren and Suzhou", systematically displaying Wu Zuoren's artistic thought of "art for life" and his deep affection for hometown.

Along with the Yan Wenliang Memorial Hall and Wu Zuoren Art Museum, which belong to the Suzhou Municipal Center of Public Culture, there is also the Hang Mingshi Pastel Art Museum located on the bank of the Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal. Not far away is the Suzhou Stone Lake scenic spot. It can be said that the beauty is in the museum, and the museum is in the painting.

As the first pastel art museum in China, the Hang Mingshi Pastel Art Museum has a construction area of 1,600 square meters, and has successively launched exhibitions such as "Hangmingshi Pastel Exhibition" and "The No. 1 Master of Calendar Picture Art, Hang Zhiying Art Documentary Exhibition". It regularly carries out the "Face to Face with Masters" pastel painting salon, which has become a shining cultural card of Suzhou.





Jiangnan Imperial Examination Hall was built in 1168, and it was initially the examination venue for prefecture and sub-prefecture schools. After the expansion, it reached its peak during the reign of the Emperor Tongzhi in the Qing Dynasty. It covered an area of 300,000 square meters, which included 20,644 exam cells. It produced the largest number of Zhuangyuan (the highest scorer), Bangyan (the second highest scorer), and Tanhua (the third highest scorer). It was the most influential examination hall in Chinese history.

The construct of the Imperial Examination Museum of China in Nanjing is based on the site of Jiangnan Imperial Examination Hall, and it is a theme museum that systematically reflects the ancient Chinese imperial examination system and culture. It consists of three parts, which includes the main body of the four-story underground museum, the preservation area of Mingyuan Mansion, and the imperial examination themed culture experience zone in the south pavilion. You can learn about the thousand years' history of the imperial examination, the examinees' challenging experience of preparing for exams, as well as the mass culture influenced by the imperial examination. You would experience the prosperity of Nanjing as the center of the examination in southern areas and understand the historical value of the imperial examination system.

The Chinese imperial examination system has lasted for more than a thousand years since its founding during the Sui Dynasty.

The collections in the museum are mainly documents and archives, ancient engraving books, calligraphy and painting, furniture couplets, ceramics, silk fabrics and so on. There is also a precious champion plaque in the exhibition hall. The plaque is decorated with hollow carved figure paintings, depicting scenes.

In order to allow the audience to deeply perceive the ancient imperial examination culture, the museum uses many technologies and multimedia means. On the big screen at the entrance of the welcome hall, animated short films such as *Fish Leaping Over the Dragon Gate* are played. As long as a scholar passes the Palace Examination and become a "Jinshi", this achievement would be called "Mount Longmen", implying that a "fish" becomes a "dragon", and



making the start of being a political official.

Kuixingtang's "Kuixing Diandou" is a popular interactive device for audiences. Kuixing is the star official in charge of the imperial examination and literary movement in ancient legends. The ceiling is designed as a starry night sky, through highlighting the dipper, the scene implies the allusion of the blessing of Kuixing. Visitors could have an immersive experience when admiring the theme film about a candidate's journey of testing projected on the circular screen above the wall.

Since the Song Dynasty, "Succeeding in the Imperial Exam" had been regarded as one of the four universally recognized greatest pleasures in one's life. Succeeding in the Imperial Examination by studying hard was every intellectual scholar's life ideal in the past, and a magnificent glory for individual and their family, was even prevalent as a social value.

I feel very lucky to experience the profound history and culture of Jiangnan Imperial Examination Hall which is more than 800 years old.

Curious about technology, some Chinese friends and I visited the Nanjing Science and Technology Museum in summer vacation. As soon as we arrived at our destination, I noticed the special and innovative shape of the main building, which looked like a giant oval flying saucer from a distance and a submarine up close. My friend told me that it was designed by a famous Canadian designer, inspired by the Nautilus from the science fiction novel Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea by Jules Verne. Another distinctive feature of this place compared to other science museums lies in its beautiful park. It includes a wetland park, a back hill, a ceremonial square and other outdoor attractions. The vast space in front of

the main building is called the ceremonial square, and the park is divided into two sides, east and west, by the main road. The park is full of greenery, which makes you feel like entering a new world. All the plants and animals in the park are accompanied by explanatory signs with scientific information about the species, making it easy for visitors to learn abo nature at leisure.

The first floor of the exhibition hall shows sor knowledge of plants, water and the earth, from which you can learn some common sense, such as where the daily water comes from, how to make trees grow faster. The second floor shows the extensive application of artificial intelligence technology. A variety of technology products charm me a lot, such as machine fish, music robots. The most interesting thing is that there are many interactive games related to science and technology in the exhibition hall, allowing visitors to experience the unique feelings brought by science and explore the scientific mysteries behind the magical phenomena, so as to achieve the effect of education and entertainment. Nanjing Science and Technology Museum truly integrates science and technology with humanities, arts and nature.

uzhou people's mung bean soup is different, with more than 10 kinds of ingredients: red and green shreds, glutinous rice, mung beans, wax gourd sugar, candied dates, raisins, kidney beans... Paired with chilled mint water, it is the best "life-sustaining weapon" for Suzhou people in summer. The earlier Suzhou mung bean soup was roughly divided into the traditional version with lily and mung beans as the representative ingredients, and the highend version with red and green shreds, wax gourd sugar, and candied dates as the representative ingredients. Now on the market, the high-end version of Suzhou mung bean soup has gradually replaced the traditional version, and has become the most representative summer heat-relieving weapon in the streets and alleys of Suzhou.

Suzhou Sour Plum Soup



For native Suzhou people, to quench their thirst in summer, a cup of traditional sour plum soup is indispensable. The ingredient selection and production of sour plum soup are very particular. The main raw material is dried plums, called sour plums, also known as black plums, and its "predecessor" is green plums. After picking the plums, they are dried at low temperature to make black plums, which are then boiled with ginger, white sugar, brown sugar, sweet-scented osmanthus and other ingredients using an old-fashioned method. On a hot summer day, drinking a sip of the cold sour plum soup spreads its unique sweet and sour aroma to the bottom of the heart. Savoring it, the sweetness and mellow fragrance are enough to dilute all the troubles of summer. In the old days, most of the sour plum soup was supplied by fruit shops or candy stores, and it was purely handmade. Today, although it has been changed to machine production, the mellow taste of sour plum soup has not changed over the years. Every summer, you can still buy bottled sour plum concentrated juice or canned sour plum soup in Suzhou traditional candy stores and souvenir shops.

In recent years, many cultural and tourism venues have produced the cultural and creative ice cream with the elements of the scenic spots. Holding the cultural and creative ice cream to take pictures has become the "standard practice" for many people on the tour.

Yangzhou Slender West Lake Wuting

Bridge Ice Cream: In the Slender West Lake, Wuting Bridge is like a slim and graceful lotus. Have a bite of the small and exquisite Wuting Bridge ice cream with milky fragrance, you're enjoying a way of Huaiyang life.

Suzhou Humble Administrator's Garden Jianshan Tower Ice Cream: Open the window of the tower, you can see peaks after peaks and feel a carefree and leisure life without going out of the city. The unique fan-shaped ice cream allows you to enjoy a feast for both the sight and taste. The signature of Suzhou is printed on the stick, which can also be collected as a bookmark.

Xuzhou "Landmark" Cultural and Creative Ice Cream: Students from the Youth Learning Club of Xuzhou Open University designed the cultural and creative ice cream of various shapes based on Xuzhou's landmark buildings, including Yunlong Mountain, Yanzi Tower, Xima Stage, Jiuli Mountain, Sugong Pagoda,

Pengzu Garden, the concert hall and others. There are strawberry, green orange and other flavors and they are made of milk powder, cream, pulp and so on. The words "I love Xuzhou", printed on ice cream sticks, indicate the original taste of old Xuzhou.

Zhenjiang Vinegar Culture Museum, Nanjing Museum, and **Imperial Examination Museum** of China in Nanjing have respectively

reproduced Hengshun Sauce and Vinegar Factory, the underglaze red plum vase with the pattern of three durable plants in winter - pine, bamboo and plum blossom made in the Hongwu period of the Ming Dynasty that is the most precious treasure of Nanjing Museum, and Mingyuan Tower as the shape of the cultural and creative ice cream with symbols of the scenic area, and launched strawberry, cream, yellow rice wine, aromatic vinegar, soy sauce cheese and other flavors based on their exclusive features.



Huai'an Qingjiangpu Tower Ice Cream: As

the first cultural and creative ice cream in Huai'an, Qingjiangpu ice cream was created by Huai'an Group of Culture and Tourism. In terms of shape, it chose Qingjiangpu Tower, a characteristic building with Huai'an Grand Canal culture. Standing at the intersection of the southern water villages and the northern plain, you may as well hold the ice cream in hand and take a picture for yourself to record the moment.

Xuanwu Lake Cultural and Creative Ice

Cream: It's modeled on Xuanwu Gate, every pillar, doorway, window and every detail of which is highly restored on the ice cream. The left side of the Xuanwu Gate is decorated with plum blossoms, and the upper right corner is a bright moon, implying happiness as perfect as the flowers and the full moon. The tradition of appreciating

plum blossoms and the moon at Xuanwu Lake is also integrated into it. In 2022, the Xuanwu Lake Scenic Area has also launched a new series of cultural and creative ice creams with cherry blossoms. Four plump cherry blossoms are crowded together, which is quite cute.

NAU Ice Cream: Nanjing Agricultural University's "Nong-flavor" cultural and creative ice cream combines the latest scientific research achievements of the tea science major of Nanjing Agricultural University, and has launched three flavors of green tea, black tea and dark tea. The design focuses on the main school building, the enrollment mascot Nanxiaonong, and NAU Roast Chicken. These cultural symbols that are deeply rooted in the

hearts of people are lively and lovable. As an ice cream combined with technology, "Nong-flavor" ice cream relies on the technical process of the technical team of the Institute of Tea Science of Nanjing Agricultural University, selects highquality Nanjing Yuhua Tea as the raw material, and adopts stone-grinding micron-level wall-breaking technology and ultra-low temperature ultra-fine grinding to retain beneficial components such as tea polyphenols, amino acids and multivitamins in the raw tea material.

Niushou Mountain Cultural and Creative Ice Cream: In the middle of the ice cream are the representative Usnisa Palace and Usnisa Pagoda of Niushou Mountain. Against the background of the

pond water and lotus, you're holding the majestic Niushou Mountain in the palm of your hand. The ice cream stick contains blessings such as "Bullish Lucky", and the scenic area also launched a cultural and creative ice cream in the shape of the Fengling Tower.

Jiming Temple Cherry Blossom

Ice Cream: Jiming Temple in Nanjing combines the ancient temple building Bhaisajyaguru Pagoda with the Jiming Temple Road Cherry Blossom Avenue, and the characteristics of Jiming Temple are carefully carved on the ice cream, so that tourists can enjoy the taste of spring in summer. The ice cream stick has a signature inside, which can also be used as a bookmark collection.

Lianyungang Banpu Bean Jelly

The special snack in Banpu Town, Lianyungang, is made by diluting the starch of beans or sweet potatoes into a paste and then condensing it. It is smooth and elastic in shape, tender in the mouth, slippery on the palate but not greasy, and tastes refreshing and fragrant mixed with garlic, sesame oil, vinegar, chili sauce and other seasonings.

Suqian Crystal Hawthorn Cake

It is a special traditional cake in Suqian which is beautiful in color and tastes refreshing. It's yellowish and transparent like crystal, hence the name. Its main raw material is high-quality iron ball hawthorn which is so named because of its hardness and iron ball-like shape. It feels icy and slippery in the mouth, promotes the secretion of saliva and nourishes the face, and whets the appetite in summer.

Suzhou Fan Cold Noodles

Steam the noodles with eggs and alkaline water, boil in boiled water for a while and fished them up, mixed with a little cooked onion oil, cool it with a fan, and then mixed with sesame oil, shrimp soy sauce, bean sprouts, shredded cucumber, shredded chicken or minced pork and pickled beans. This is Suzhou Fan Cold Noodles. It tastes smooth and not sticky, with a refreshing fragrance and chewy texture.



Taizhou Rice-bit Porridge

Rice-bit porridge refers to porridge made from highland barley and rice. Highland barley is naked barley. There is a custom of eating this porridge in Taizhou, Jiangsu, and it has the reputation of "Taizhou black coffee". To make this porridge, it is necessary to add a little alkaline water to cook the porridge into red or light brown. The locals often get up in the morning to cook porridge, and come back from work to drink cold porridge, which alleviates the inner heat and nourishes the stomach and tastes refreshing and silky.

Yangzhou Old Goose

Just having porridge is a bit bland. Adding some fresh flavor might be better. Yangzhou is known as the "Goose City" and the old goose in Yangzhou can be served in a banquet and also be cooked at home. The old geese in the urban areas of Huangjue, Gaoyou Lingtang, Baoying Wubao, and Yizheng Chadao, etc. are especially famous, and Huangjue old goose is even rated as an Intangible Cultural Heritage Project. Yangzhou people like eating geese and consume more than 20 million geese a year with an average of more than 40,000 geese per day. Especially in summer, people like to eat a morsel of chopped old goose to sips of beer. How pleasant!



Wuxi Braised Goose

Wuxi people have the habit of eating braised dishes in summer, and the braised goose is one of the most representative ones. Goose meat is not only nutritious, but also has certain effects of dietary therapy.







Dongtai Watermelon



It's a special local product of Dongtai, Yancheng City. The peel is smooth with bright light green covered with dark green stripes, and the flesh is bright red and full of refreshing juice. In April 2020, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs officially approved the registration of National Geographical Indication of Agricultural Products for "Dongtai Watermelon".



It's a specialty of Jiangning District, Nanjing City, which is petite and exquisite with fresh yellow flesh. The sandy soil in the low mountain and hilly areas of Hengxi, the unique conditions of temperature, light, water and fertilizer, as well as the comprehensive application of fine varieties and advanced cultivation techniques, have made the Hengxi watermelon thinskinned, crisp, sweet, juicy and refreshing.

Jurong Grape

It's the specialty of Jurong, Zhenjiang City, which is thin-skinned, tender and succulent with small seeds, and you won't get tired of it after taking a lot. Jurong has now become the largest production base of table grapes in Jiangsu Province, with more than 20 varieties of grapes, including Xiahei, Kyoho, Meirenzhi, Guigongzi, Guigongzhu, Giant Rose, and Golden Finger, with a picking period lasting more than 100 days.

Wuxi Yangshan Peach



Wuxi Yangshan peach is produced in Yangshan Town, Wuxi City, Jiangsu Province, a famous peach town in China. The peach fruit is large in shape, beautiful in color, tough and easy to peel, rich in aroma, juicy and sweet. It's so tender that it melts in the mouth, and has the reputation of "flesh made of water".



Suzhou Baiyu Loquat and Qingzhong Loquat

Suzhou Baiyu loquat and Qingzhong loquat are new varieties of Baisha series planted in Dongshan, Xishan and other places in Wuzhong District of Suzhou. They mature in early summer each year, with round, sweet and juicy fruits. Baiyu loquat can be rated the "king of kings" among loquats. The flesh is as white as white jade, and the skin is thin and easy to tear. When you bite it, the sweet juice wraps your taste buds.

The Qingzhong loquat in Xishan is also not a false name . It is large, thinskinned, fleshy, with a small core, delicate and smooth in taste, sweet and refreshing, pleasantly sour and juicy.

Suzhou Cuiguan Pear

Suzhou Shushan Cuiguan pear is sweet and juicy, with thin skin, a small core, delicate and tender flesh, and full of juice. It is known as "June Snow".

Nantong Lvsi Port is famous in the Jiangsu sea area for the highest yield and the best quality of jellyfish. Especially in summer, crispy tripe tips with jellyfish heads are a refreshing musteat dish for Nantong people. The crispy tripe tip is commonly known as "pig tripe". Choose fresh tripe tips, boil them in boiling water, add ginger and green onion to remove the fishy smell, and cut

the cooked fresh tripe tips into strips before placing them on a plate with fresh jellyfish. Take another small bowl, pour aromatic vinegar, soy sauce, and chili oil, and sprinkle with minced ginger and green onion to make a seasoning bowl. The jellyfish is crisp, tender and fresh, and the tripe tip is soft and chewy. Then dip them in the spicy and sour seasoning - how wonderful!

Changzhou Changdang Lake Seed Shrimp

"Eat crabs in autumn and shrimps in summer" is a tradition of Changzhou people to enjoy seasonal delicacies. The most attractive summer delicacy is Changdang Lake seed shrimp, one of the eight fresh foods in Changdang Lake. Braised Three Shrimp Parts refers to the three parts of seed shrimp - shrimp meat, shrimp roe and shrimp

brain. Fresh ingredients, meticulous processing, and just the right amount of heat make this worldly delicacy. Diners who really know cuisine will never waste any kind of ingredients. Larger seedless lake shrimp can be made into fried saltand-pepper shrimp, and smaller ones can be made into raw shrimp dressed with sauce.







Huai'an Xuyi Lobster

It starts on the first day of the dog days and ends on the last day of it every year, which lasts for one month. Eating mutton in the hottest days is treating heat



in the body with heat and helping the body to sweat and detoxify, removing the dampness in winter and spring. It is a method of food therapy.









hen it comes to summer delicacies, zongzi cannot be missed, which is the iconic food of the Dragon Boat Festival.

The fifth day of the fifth lunar month is the Dragon Boat Festival which has a history of more than 2,500 years. It was originally a festival for the Chinese people to cure diseases and prevent epidemics. Later, the festival and custom of expelling poison and warding off evil spirits gave rise to a variety of folklore activities such as sacrifices, entertainment and health care.

As one of the important traditional folklore festivals in China, the Dragon Boat Festival was the first Chinese festival to be included in the UNESCO Intangible Cultural List. The Dragon Boat Festival activities all over the country are rich in content. Among them, the unique custom in Suzhou, one of the four important heritage sites of the Chinese Dragon Boat Festival, was selected into the UNESCO Intangible Cultural List in 2000

Whether it is recalling Wu Zixu, a famous general of the State of Wu in the Spring and Autumn Period, commemorating the



death of Qu Yuan, a scholar of the State of Chu, or cherishing the filial daughter Cao E of the Eastern Han Dynasty, the Dragon Boat Festival is full of sincere feelings towards the family and the country, and is the spiritual homeland of Chinese people.

Fresh meat zongzi, sweetened bean paste zongzi, red date zongzi, bacon and egg yolk zongzi, red bean zongzi, white glutinous rice zongzi... Now there are endless varieties of zongzi, Zongzi, with 2000 years of history, is also becoming more and more fashionable, and zongzi in the blind box is very popular this year. According to the person in charge of Tmall Supermarket, the tea drink flavor is the representative of the new taste of zongzi on the e-commerce platform this year. With tea and tea sets, zongzi changes from staple food to dessert. The consumption scene of zongzi has also moved from the festive dinner table to afternoon tea, which can also meet the ceremonial sense of camping and picnic.

DRAGON BOAT **FESTIVAL CUSTOMS**

in Suzhou are Included in the UNESCO **Intangible Cultural List**

As one of the four important heritage sites of the Dragon Boat Festival in China, Suzhou's Dragon Boat Festival customs were included in the UNESCO Intangible Cultural List in 2009, with the same level as Suzhou gardens.

The origin of the Dragon Boat Festival in Suzhou can be traced back to Wu Zixu, a famous general of the Wu State during the Spring and Autumn Period. Later, with the development of Suzhou's society, economy and culture, the Dragon Boat Festival, which started in memory of Wu Zixu, gradually evolved into a grand annual carnival, forming a complete set of Dragon Boat Festival folklore activities corresponding to Suzhou's natural climatic conditions, daily production and life, economic characteristics and cultural development.

Wu Zixu was a general of the Wu state in the Spring and Autumn Period. He helped Helv, the King of Wu, build the famous Helv city and laid the foundation

for the prosperity of the Wu state. Later, he assisted Fuchai, another King of Wu, and achieved the great cause of occupying the southeast and dominating the Central Plains. And he not only built the city of Suzhou, but also endowed this ancient city with the soul of water. The Xujiang River leading to Taihu Lake, the moat surrounding the city, and the three horizontal and four straight rivers in the city together outline the skeleton of Suzhou City. Thousands of years later, the Grand Canal also extended and expanded on the basis of these waterways, and the rivers flowed endlessly, bringing countless prosperity to the South of the Yangtze River.

After Wu Zixu died, the people of Wu would row dragon boats in Xujiang River and other places to commemorate him every year at the Dragon Boat Festival in May. Dragon boat racing is a Dragon Boat Festival custom that is very popular among Suzhou people. Each dragon boat will be very ornately decorated. The "dragon

head" of the boat is high, the "dragon tail" is raised, and the hull is painted with dragon scales in various colors. Colorful banners and flags are fluttering and flying. During the race, the warriors row hard to the beat of the drums splashing waves. On the shore, gongs and drums are deafening, and the audience are swarming like clouds, exuding a hubbub of voices.

In addition to the dragon boat races in Xujiang, Xumen, Changmen, Fengqiao and Shantang to commemorate Wu Zixu, the Dragon Boat Festival activities in Suzhou involve almost all aspects of people's daily life, such as clothing, food, housing and transportation: Suzhou local customs of life wisdom formed to adapt to nature and humanities, such as picking herbs, making realgar wine, making sachets, hanging wormwood and calamus, hanging pictures of Zhongkui (a mythical figure who could drive away evil spirits in Chinese folklore), etc.; customs about Suzhou's long silk weaving culture and unique clothing

culture, such as wearing clothes printed with five poisonous creatures, tiger-head shoes, tiger-head belly bands, and colorful ropes, etc.; customs related to Suzhou food culture traditions, such as making zongzi and eating Duanwu lunch.

Suzhou people will hang green calamus and wormwood on the front of their house, supplemented by garlic. The leaves of the calamus are shaped like swords, and are called "water swords" by the people, which are said to be able to "kill thousands of evil spirits" and avoid "five poisons". In fact, because the early summer is humid, the herbal smell of calamus and mugwort can play a role in repelling mosquitoes. Suzhou people also wear sachets, which are embroidered with patterns of flowers, birds and beasts with silk threads, and contain Chinese herbs such as realgar, atractylodes, vanilla, etc., which have the effect of dispelling plague and poison.

During the Dragon Boat Festival, many ex-

periential activities were launched in scenic spots in Suzhou, such as dragon boat races, garden tours in traditional "hanfu", and sachet making. In Suzhou, the Dragon Boat Festival holiday saw a growth of nearly 25% in the popularity of tourism-related search terms such as "intangible cultural heritage" and "culture", according to TravelGo.

In recent years, the environment and features of the Xujiang area in Suzhou and the ancient Xumen City Wall have been restored, and a theme cultural park with the stone statue of Wu Zixu as a symbol has been built in the Xujiang area. The annual Jinji Lake Dragon Boat Race has become a grand event for Suzhou people to celebrate the Dragon Boat Festival in the new era. From Xujiang River to Jinji Lake, from Changmen North Wharf to Moonlight Wharf, things have changed with time, but people's inheritance of Wu's folk customs has always been the same, and their yearning for a better life has never changed.

Hang Nanjing Colored Zongzi

Wear Zhenjiang Tiger-head Shoes

Nanjing's colored zongzi production skill for Dragon Boat Festival is a traditional skill in the list of representative items of municipal intangible cultural heritage. It's said that, originally, zongzi was colored to protect it from being eaten by flood dragons after being thrown into the Miluo River. Nowadays, the small and exquisite colored zongzi has become a mascot in the eyes of many people. It is believed to exorcize evil spirits, avoid disasters, and pray for blessings. At Dragon Boat Festival, the elder Nanjing people will hang colorful zongzi at home and also send colored zongzi to each other, and they'll put five cereals in the colored zongzi to symbolize a bumper harvest.

n addition to hanging colored zongzi, children in Nanjing will stuff a salted duck egg into a bag made of five-color silk threads during the Dragon Boat Festival. If this salted duck egg comes from Gaoyou, Yangzhou, it will be enviable. The craftsmanship of Gaoyou salted duck eggs has been included in the list of representative items of intangible cultural heritage in Jiangsu Province.

Salted duck eggs are a must-have for Nanjing people on the Duanwu lunch table, and they are also a good partner for zongzi, According to Mr. Xue Bing, a famous writer in Nanjing, there is a traditional folk custom of eating "five yellows" at the Dragon Boat Festival in "Jiangnan", or the area south of the downstream Yangtze River, that is, five kinds of "yellow" foods, such as salted egg yolk, eel, yellow

croaker, cucumber ("yellow mel-

on" in Chinese) and realgar wine. In the old days, people believed that the Dragon Boat Festival was a time when "yang" (a Chinese philosophical concept, opposite to "yin") prevailed the most during the year. Eating seasonal foods such as "five yellows" on this day could exorcize evil spirits and detoxify. In addition to the "five yellows", Nan-

jing people also eat "five reds": amaranth, red oil duck eggs, roast duck, river shrimp, and braised yellow croaker. With the changes of the times, the content of "five vellows" and "five reds" has changed, but in general, they are all out of a good vision to disperse poison and avoid summer heat.

During the Dragon Boat Festival, adults can drink realgar wine or calamus wine, while children love sesame oil mung bean cake and red oil duck eggs. Tie colorful ropes, hang folium artemisiae argyi sachets, wear colorful velvet flowers, draw gourd paintings... Nanjing's various intangible cultural heritage folk customs of the Dragon Boat Festival dress up the children beautifully and fragrantly.

stealing lucid ganoderma to rescue her husband and flooding the Jinshan Temple after failing to find her husband. The love story of Bai Suzhen and Xu Xian puts on a veil of amorous feelings for the Dragon Boat Festival, and adds a layer of mystery to Zhenjiang.

The Dragon Boat Festival floats



anjing Shitang Bamboo Sea is located at the junction of Jiangsu and Anhui. It is nestled against Jiulong Pond, boasting 30,000 mu (2,000 hectares) of contiguous green bamboo. The two mountains of bamboo with deep greenery, interspersed with a pool of clear water, are refreshing and pleasant. Thanks to the tea

mountain, bamboo sea, pine waves and virid pond, coupled with the large-scale planting of moso bamboo, it can preserve water and soil resources, adjust the local microclimate, and the air is rich in negative oxygen ions, so tourists in the scenic spot can experience a temperature about 2°C lower than the outside. The Shitang Renjia (Shitang Village) next to the Shitang Bamboo Sea is an ancient village surrounded by green mountains. In the village, you can taste roasted pork with bamboo shoots, and drink bamboo leaf tea to clear away the boredom and anxiety in the summer. It takes 20 minutes by car to reach the Seven Immortals Dafu Village, which is

the legendary place where the Seven Fairies descended. As the origin of the folk love between Dong Yong and one of the Seven Fairies, it is also very romantic.

The Nanshan Bamboo Sea in Changzhou on the conjunction of the three provinces, Jiangsu, Zhejiang and Anhui, even embraces thousands of mu of bamboo forest. It is away from the hustle and bustle of the city and has a unique microclimate. The boundless moso bamboo, surrounded by mountains and boulders, emits a fragrance that can be smelled. The unique natural ecology has formed a summer resort with a natural temperature 2 °C lower than other places.

Tianmu Lake in Changzhou is surrounded by mountains, in which islets are scattered, with the water and the sky emerging into one color. The Tianmu Lake Water World near the Tianmu Lake Tourist Resort is



surrounded by mountains and rivers, which provides a refreshing ecological water-playing experience. There is also bamboo sea rafting in Tianmu Lake, which is close to Nanshan Bamboo Sea. Floating down along the current with a 360-degree turn, you'll immerse yourself in the cool stream water, and feel the feeling of riding the wind and breaking the waves.

Qingliang Mountain in Nanjing has been a summer resort since ancient times, and was once the summer palace of the emperors of the Southern Tang Dynasty. The mountains in the park are undulating, the trees are lush, the river breeze is refreshing, and there are many bamboos that bring coolness. There is the largest ginkgo grove in Nanjing City, and various trees such as Liriodendron Chinese whose canopies are like green umbrellas, rendering it the "green lung" of the city. Chongzheng Academy in Qingliang Mountain is famous for its 50-year-old sweet viburnum. When it is not in bloom, it is a cyan bud. When it blooms, the color of the flowers changes from cyan to white. The white flowers

are full of trees like snow pressing the branches. The flowering period lasts from spring to early summer.

Not far away, Nanjing Hydrangea Park uses colorful hydrangeas to create a sea of colorful flowers in summer. The blue and purple hydrangea macrophylla "Endless Summer", the blue and white hydrangea paniculata Sieb "Snow Diamond", the pink hydrangea macrophylla "Sabrina", the light red Hydrangea Arborescens "Tiana"... Colorful flowers nestle against the park's rippling waves, bringing coolness and comfort.

Liangpengxia Village, getting its name from a cool shelter, is located at the foot of Wuxiang Mountain in Nanjing, between the remainder of Donglu Mountain and Qiuhu Mountain, adjacent to Zhongshan Lake and Yaojia Lake. The village is half hidden among the faraway mountains and nearby water. Every summer, Liangpengxia Village is surrounded by thousands of acres of mountain gardenia flowers which can be found all over the mountains and plains. They exude fragrance, and are extremely

conspicuous in a green forest. When the summer breeze sweeps past, the mountain gardenia flowers sway and the fragrance spreading with the wind even fills up the sultry air. Such a large gardenia field, even if you just pass by, will leave fragrance upon your body. In your spare time, holding a cup of gardenia tea while sitting on a reclining chair under the big tree in the tea room, smelling the fragrance of gardenia, is a pleasant relaxation. When you smell the fragrance of gardenias, you will know that the early summer is coming.

As a beautiful business card of the city's cultural and people-benefit brand, *Meet at the Ancient Stage* has performed more than 200 times since its debut on Nov. 1, 2015, benefiting nearly 100,000 audiences. It not only sent the dance drama *My Liulaozhuang*, the Huangmei Opera *Fairy Couple*, the Huai Opera Excerpt *The No.1 Scholar and the Beggar* and other cultural feasts to local residents, but also opened up a "holy place for learning" for the vast number of local opera talents.

In addition to the characteristic "small theater", Huai'an has also "woven" a service network of "Famous Artists Stationing in Villages", where famous municipal masters come to the village to give lectures, district-level famous masters station in villages for training, and the town's literary and art teams pair up with the villages to help them. Villagers can be "face-to-face" with famous artists easily.

Listening to a literary class in a rural courtyard, watching a classic Huai Opera in a local theater, and admiring masterpieces in the painting and calligraphy base... Such "down-to-earth" literary and artistic enjoyment has an ordinary part of Huai'an people's daily life.









The Mazhuang Village is located in Pan'anhu Street, Jiawang District, Xuzhou City, which used to be "half coal ash and half soil". After unremitting efforts, it has now achieved "half green hills and half lake", changing from a poor and backward small village in the past to a national key village for rural tourism. What comes with it is the continuous enlargement of cultural symbols.

In 1988, a legendary farmer brass band was established, namely Mazhuang Farmers Orchestra. Members of the orchestra were all villagers from Mazhuang Village. Peasants tried to play Western musical instruments with their hands that once held sickles and hoes and presented popular performances in the fields. Without the guidance of teachers, they went to the music department of colleges and universities to invite them; without training sites, they trained in the field. Under the principles and policies of the Communist Party of China, the orchestra arranges literary and artistic works that are close to reality, life, and the masses, focusing on the rich and colorful life of the masses in the countryside. Over the past 30 years, the Farmers Orchestra has trained more than 300 people. They went to Italy and Japan to participate in competitions, and gave exchange performances with art groups and friends from more than 20 countries and regions including Russia, Canada, France, Austria, and Spain, showing the charm of Chinese culture and the style of farmers in the new era of Mazhuang.

n the seventh day of the seventh unar month is a traditional Chinese folk festival - Qixi, Chinese Valentine's Day. Qixi is endowed with the beautiful love legend of "The Cowherd and the Weaver Lady". According to legend, on the seventh day of the seventh lunar month, the Cowherd and the Weaver Lady will meet on the Magpie Bridge in the sky. Praying for blessings, begging for craftsmanship, sitting and watching Altair and Vega, and praying for marriage are all traditional customs of Qixi.

This year's Qixi will fall on Aug, 4, and it's the best time to talk about sweet things.

Nanjing Luhe Pingshan Forest Park is located in the Pingshan Forest Farm, where the mountains and forests are rolling and green, and the tea garden in the forest is like a blanket. The Dreamland Park here has 1,314 cypress trees, symbolizing lifelong fidelity, and it is a must-go place for Qixi. Next to the "Lovers Stone" in the park, you can overlook the east to watch the sunrise, which is even more romantic. In addition to Dreamland Park, you can also go to the Forest Adventure Park, Cuiming Lake Aquatic Park, and Pingshan Tearoom. In summer, you can drift on the blue waves and enjoy a panoramic

view of the lakes and mountains.

The most recommended item for Qixi is the romantic rose. The bright colors are like the fiery romance in midsummer. Luhe Fengcai Mancheng has 500 acres of roses. It doesn't matter if you miss the full bloom of roses; vou can buy rose essential oil as a souvenir to keep the sweet fragrance, or you may as well have a bath in the hot spring full of rose petals. Witnessing the long-lasting and colourful love, crape myrtles, sunflowers and hydrangeas also should not be missed.

Lotus and lily have a good omen of sweetness and happiness in China because they're the homonym for "a hundred years of happiness" (Bai Nian Hao He). More than 3,000 square meters of lilies have been planted around the Guanyin Temple in Jiangning District, Nanjing, with various varieties and colors. Nanjing Luhe Chishan Lake Wetland Park is a "paradise for birds", accompanied by aquatic reeds and cattail. Every spring and summer breeding season, more than 30,000 wild birds of more than 20 species such as egrets, golden herons, night herons, herons, mallards, pheasants, wild geese, coots, gray cranes, and hoopoe inhabit it. In recent years, 2,000 mu (133 hectares) of root lotus, 100 lotus ponds of seed lotus, and 300 mu

(20 hectares) of Indian red water lily have been newly cultivated and developed here, including more than 150 domestic varieties. It is a veritable "Bai Lian Hao He" garden. The pronunciation is similar to "Bai Nian Hao He", which means "forever love" in Chinese.

When it comes to appreciating lotus, except for Xuanwu Lake and Lianhua Lake in Nanjing, the Xigeng Lianxiang Village in Pukou District, Nanjing is also recommended. You can go boating in the lotus pond, enjoy the flowers on the plank road, breathe the faint fragrance of lotus flowers, and enjoy the boundless greenery before your eyes.

In the Lotus Expo Park, there are 580 lotus ponds and 2.5 kilometers of water lily rivers in Xigeng Lianxiang, where nearly 600 varieties of lotus and more than 200 varieties of water lilies are planted. In the summer when the cicadas are buzzing everywhere, the lotus leaves grow well in the fields, the lotus pods are newly green, and the lotus roots are fresh and sweet. What a beautiful scenery that would amaze the French painter

You can also try lotus root juice and lotus leaf tea, and taste lotus pond delicacies such as fried lotus root with beef fillet, steamed pork

ribs on the lotus leaf, sliced lotus root with sweet sauce, etc. In the old days, lotus leaves were a great eco-friendly thing for wrapping rice and cooked food. It's definitely worth a try to buy some lotus root powder and sweet red heart lotus seeds as a souvenir.

In the glass greenhouse of Xigeng Lianxiang Village, you can see the beauty of Victoria cruziana, the "Hercules in the Water". The leaves of Victoria cruziana are about 1.5 to 2 meters in diameter, like a large disc, which is a treasure in the water garden. As the temperature continues to rise, the leaves of Victoria cruziana will grow larger,

which is expected to satisfy tourists under 50 kilograms to stand on the "Water Hercules" and experience roaming about in a green

There are three whites in the summer in "Jiangnan", or the area south of the downstream Yangtze River - jasmine, white magnolia and gardenia, which are very suitable for decoration on the chest or hair.

Xiangtang Taoyuan Valley in Pukou District is located at the southern foot of Laoshan Mountain, and gardenia fields are hidden in the valleys surrounded by mountains on

three sides. Gardenia elements are prominent in various places in Xiangtang Village. Even the coffee shops in the village are named after gardenias. It is also a pleasure to order a cup of coffee in a mountain village simply to enjoy the calmness. The campsite here is also highly recommended. Sitting in the tent, before your eyes are green rice fields and forests of Laoshan Mountain. With smoky wind in the mountains, floating clouds in the sky, and the smell of sweet gardenias, you'll only feel that the years are like flowers, pleasing to both the eye and the mind. Who do you want to share the fragrance of the midsummer with?

Bamboo rafts are made of bundled bamboo and are popular in"Jiangnan", or the area south of the downstream Yangtze River. 
Water Parks

- Nanjing Jiangning Gingko Lake Park is an amusement park themed around ecology. The park is centered on Ginkgo Lake, surrounded by mountains and rivers. In the hot summer, a mysterious and thrilling "fantasy rafting" in the park is a must; you can also enjoy the natural landscapes such as mountains, waters, flowers and birds in the ecological leisure area.
- ➤ Huachang Dragon Valley in Nanjing, located on the bank of the Yangtze River, is the largest fully indoor cultural tourism scenic spot in Asia. It has five themed scenes: Dragon Valley Town, Storm Water World, Longzang Valley, Fantasy Future, and Secret Rainforest. Among them, there are many water sports such as water castle adventure, infinity pool, sand island for paddling, treasure island exploration and so on in Storm Water World. Come to play in the water and have fun in summer, embrace the waves here affectionately, and enjoy the coolness.
- Playa Maya Water Park is located on the east side of Qixia Mountain, adjacent to the Yangtze River. It combines the mysterious Mayan civilization with modern water entertainment. It has more than 20 sets of large-scale water rides equipment, allowing tourists to enjoy the coolness of the refreshing wind.
- ➤ Tangshan Happy Water World is located in Tangshan, Nanjing. It has a wave pool with waves up to 3 meters high, the powerful impact of which brings people infinite happiness; 10,000 m² of the real sand beach allows people to enjoy the scenery as on the Gold Coast; 1,000 meters of dream rafting takes you to the wonderful fun of wandering in the ocean. It takes 10 minutes' drive to Ziqing Lake from here. You can visit the Panda House during the day. In the evening, you can enjoy the forest hot spring surrounded by greenery and eliminate the fatigue of playing during the day.

On the Dragon Boat Festival, the dragon boat races on Xuanwu Lake become exciting again, and the thunderous drums and shouts






While we talk about Ultimate Frisbee, people may have no idea with this kind of sport originally started from the State of New Jersey, the U.S. It has a history of over 50 years, covering specific rules of American football, basketball and rugby. There are two seven-a-side teams would play on a rectangular field. The objective of each team is to score a goal by having a player catch a pass in the end zone that they are attacking. A thrower should not run with the disc, but may pass the disc in any direction to any teammate. The other team shall take possession and attempt to score in the opposite end zone. Games are typically played to 15 goals or around 100 minutes.

There is another important point of Ultimate is we won't have any judge in the competition. Players and captains are solely responsible for making and resolving all calls in the field. Players need to keep contacting with opponents when their behavior causes disagreement, but if players cannot agree after discussion, the frisbee must be returned to the last non-disputed thrower.



TRAVEL TIPS

Our goal is for you to enjoy your stay in Jiangsu as much as possible. However, during these trying times, vigilance is primordial. Visitors are reminded that China has implemented the "dynamic zero-COVID approach".

- ➤ Ensure you have the necessary COVID-19 health checks in place
- > Follow the directions of authorities as to epidemic prevention
- Carry a copy of your COVID-19 vaccination certificate, if available
- ➤ Wear a face mask throughout your journey by plane, train or on any other public transport
- > Reserve suitable accommodation at a local hotel which accepts foreigners
- Download and install APPs useful for making mobile payments, e.g Alipay
- ➤ Check the validity of your passport and China visa

Also Good to Know...

- ➤ Foreigners do no longer require to get their train ticket in advance at most railway stations in Jiangsu. Station turnstiles are equipped with passport readers; buying a ticket online will suffice.
- ➤ If you require a tax invoice for your train ticket, the paper ticket will suffice, and can be obtained in the ticket office. Car -hailing platforms now have dedicated pick up spots at railway stations, usually in the car park. Car-hailing drivers are not permitted to pick up passengers at the drop-off point.
- Each metro system in Jiangsu has its own APP for seamless ticket purchase, which can be swiped at the barrier upon exit and entry. Station staff will be happy to assist in setting up the APP if necessary. Many cities' metro systems also accept payment by WeChat and/or Alipay.
