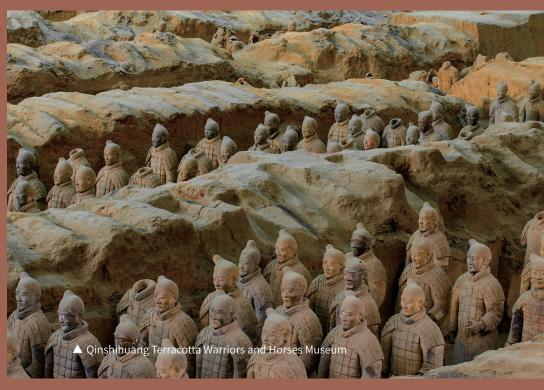

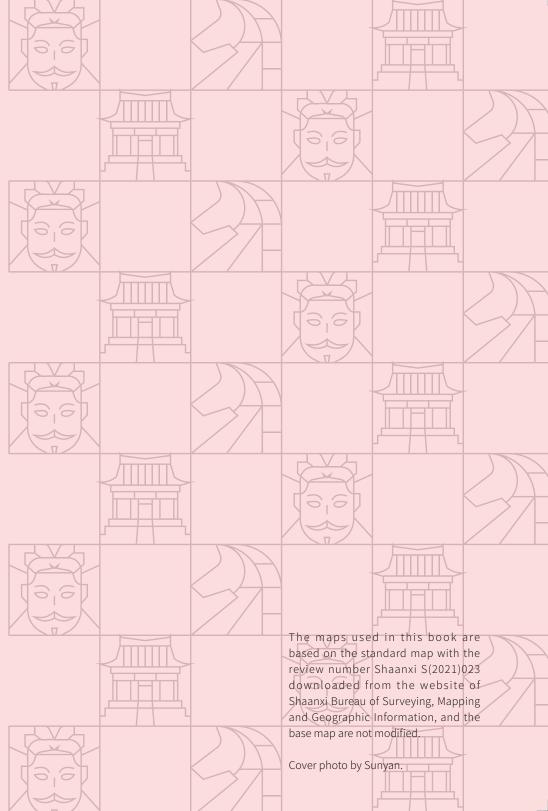








- The information in this manual is as of December 2023. If there is any change, please refer to the latest

## **Preface**



Shaanxi is one of the important birthplaces of the Chinese nation and civilization. It has witnessed the glorious history of the Zhou, Qin, Han, and Tang dynasties. It carries the Yellow Emperor Mausoleum, Terracotta Warriors and Horses, Yan'an Pagoda, Qinling Mountains, Mount Huashan, and many other Chinese civilizations, Chinese revolutions, and Chinese geography spiritual symbols and natural logos.

Museums are important halls for the protection and inheritance of human civilization, as well as the "soul carrier" of the city. From the Lantian Ape-Man Site about 1.15 million years ago, to the mysterious smile of the fish pattern on the ancient Banpo human face, from the rise of the Chinese civilization on Zhouyuan, to the spectacular shock of the Terracotta Warriors and Horses of Qin Shihuang... There are row upon row of emperor tombs and historical sites on this land. The remains have given Shaanxi the reputation of a "Natural History Museum".

According to the data released by the Shaanxi Provincial Bureau of Cultural Relics in 2021, there are 49,058 immovable cultural relics in Shaanxi Province, 7,748,750 movable cultural relics collected by 522 state-owned cultural relics collection and storage institutions, and 329 record museums (Memorials), including 9 national first grade level cultural relics museum. The rich cultural relics and profound cultural accumulation have formed the unique historical and cultural features of Shaanxi.

"Tour of Shaanxi Museum" will take you into Shaanxi, trace the thousand-year history in the dialogue with cultural relics through time and space, and enjoy a cultural feast.



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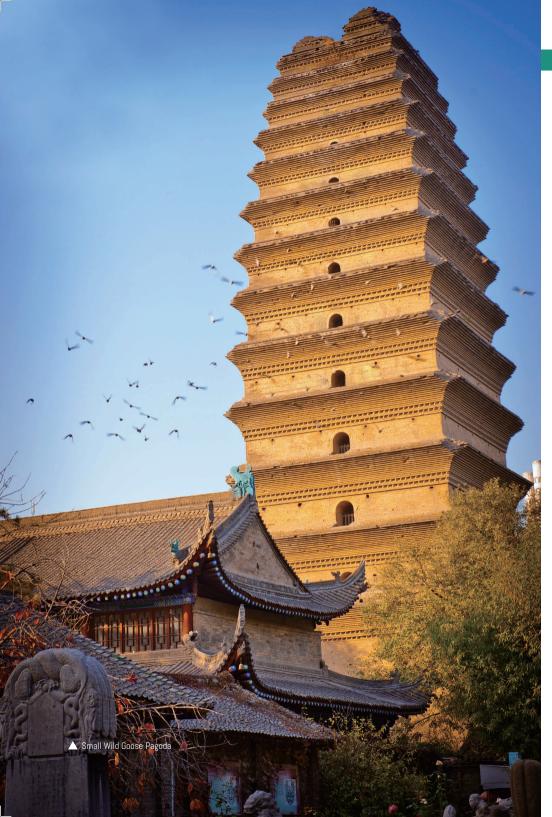


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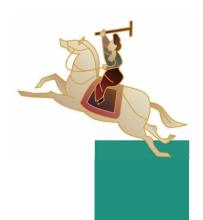
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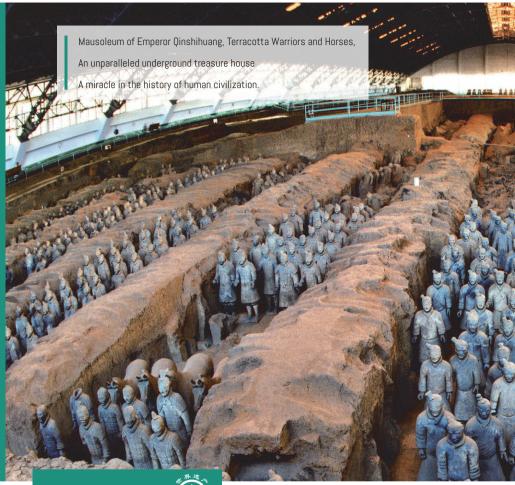

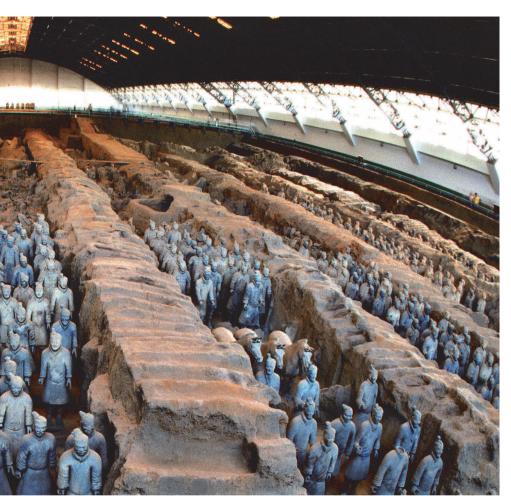


## Emperor Qinshihuang's Mausoleum Site Museum

- World Cultural Heritage
- National 5A-Rated Tourist Attraction

Qinshihuang Ying Zheng (259 BC - 210 BC) was the first emperor in Chinese history. He established the first unified, multi-ethnic, centralized feudal state in Chinese history - the Qin Empire. After he ascended the throne, he began to build a mausoleum for himself, and the construction time was as long as 39 years.

## Highlights: Terracotta Warriors and Horses, Bronze Chariots and Horses

The Emperor Qinshihuang's Mausoleum Site Museum consists of the Qinshihuang Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum and the Qinshihuang Mausoleum Site Park (Lishan Garden).

The Mausoleum of Emperor Qin Shihuang is the largest and richest imperial mausoleum ever discovered by Chinese archaeology. In this huge "underground kingdom", various burial pits, more than 600 burial tombs and building foundations of millions of square meters have been discovered, from where a large number of beautiful cultural relics such as the Qinshihuang Terracotta Warriors and Horses, painted bronze chariots and horses, Terracotta Acrobats and waterfowls made of bronze are excavated. Among them, the Terracotta Warriors and Horses are known as "the eighth wonder of the world" and "one of the greatest discoveries in the history of archaeology in the twentieth century". In 1987, the Mausoleum of Qin Shihuang (including the pit of Terracotta Warriors and Horses) was included in the World Heritage List by UNESCO, becoming the common wealth of all mankind.

## **Our Guide**

The Museum of Terracotta Warriors and Horses of Qin Shihuang includes Pit No. 1, Pit No. 2. Pit No. 3. and an exhibition hall of cultural relics.

Lishan Garden includes the seal of Qin Shihuang's mausoleum, the Qin Mausoleum Bronze Chariot and Horse Museum, the K9901 exhibition hall, the K0006 exhibition hall, and the restoration display of the inner-city walls of the Qinshihuang, the

Emperor's mausoleum.

The Terracotta Warriors and Horses Pit is the burial pit of Qinshihuang's mausoleum and the main display of Qinshihuang's Mausoleum Museum. Pit 1 is the largest and the most spectacular. Pit 2 has a complete range of arms and content, and in Pit 3 you can see painted terracotta warriors and horses.

Terracotta Warriors and Horses Pit No2:The iconic exhibition area of the Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum of Qin Shihuang. It was discovered by chance when a local farmer was digging a well in 1974, and it is the largest of the three pits (larger than two football fields).

Terracotta Warriors and Horses Pit No. 2: The essence of the Terracotta Warriors and Horses Pits. A multi-armed army formation consisting of cavalry, chariotand infantry was discovered here, among which the figurines of generals, pommel horses, and kneeling figurines were discovered for the first time. At present, Pit No. 2 displays a large area of the shed wood layer (the roof of the underground building in that year).

Terracotta Warriors and Horses Pit No. 3: There are 72 pottery figurines and pottery horses buried in the pit, which is the earliest military command found in the history of world archaeology. There are many painted remains on the unearthed pottery figurines.

The mausoleum of the first emperor of Qin: the tall mound in the south of Lishan Garden is the tomb of the first emperor of Qin. The tomb has never been excavated, and its internal conditions remain a mystery today.

K0006 burial pit (Civil Figurines pit): an unburned burial pit, which is rare in the mausoleum of the first emperor of Oin, 12 pottery figurines were unearthed.

K9901 Burial Pit (Pit of Terracotta Acrobats: The 11 pottery figurines unearthed in the pit neither wore armors nor robes. Their upper bodies were naked and and they were wearing colorful short skirts. Their postures were different, reflecting the entertainment life of the Qin court.

Qinling Bronze Chariots and Horses Museum: It mainly displays two Qinling bronze chariots and horses known as the "Crown of Bronze". The museum will be completed in 2021. The exhibition is full of technology. Visitors can experience interesting interactive projects such as driving a carriage through VR.

Cultural relics exhibition hall: It includes an academy history exhibition and a temporary exhibition hall, which hold special exhibitions of domestic and foreign high-quality cultural relics from time to time.

## **Kneeling Archer Figurine**

"Treasure of the Museum" Displayed in Terracotta Warriors and Horses Pit No. 2

Among the many terracotta warriors, it is the only one that is intact and it can be called the essence of terracotta warriors and a masterpiece of ancient Chinese sculpture arts. He was wearing a battle robe and armor, kneeling on his right knee, squatting his left leg, and staring straight ahead.



Displayed in Qinling Bronze Chariot and Horse Museum

Known as the "Crown of Bronze", it is the most complex and the largest ancient bronze ware discovered in the archaeological history of the 20th century, reproducing the style of Emperor Qin Shi Huang's imperial carriage and showing the wonderful craftsmanship of the ancients.







## Bronze Crane

#### Displayed in K0007 Bronze Waterfowl Pit

The vivid shape reproduces the wonderful moment of the crane taking food from the water, showing an ethereal and vivid beauty.

## Civil Figurines

#### Displayed in K0006 Civil Figurines

The 12 unearthed pottery figurines wear long crowns on their heads and hang a book knife on their waists. Compared with the terracotta warriors, their appearance is weaker.





#### Terracotta Acrobats

#### Displayed in K9901 Terracotta Acrobats Pit

Other terracotta warriors and horses have static shapes, while Terracotta Acrobats have dynamic shapes of "freeing themselves", with different behaviors.

## Green Face Figurine

It is the only green-faced kneeling archer figurine found in the Qin Terracotta Warriors and Horses. Because it is too precious, the green-faced figurine has only been exhibited 4 times since it is unearthed.

Shaanxi History Museum is not to be missed.

Here it condenses the historical essence of the Chinese nation,

Known as the "Pearl of the Ancient Capital, the Treasure House of China".

Highlights: Bronze Wares, Pottery Figurines, Gold and Silver Wares, Frescoes

Shaanxi History Museum is the first large-scale modern national museum in China. And the building style of this museum is that its central exhibition hall is surrounded by relatively high buildings. The collection has more than 1.7 million pieces (groups) of cultural relics, ranging from simple stone tools used by ancient humans to various witnesses of contemporary social life, with a time span of more than one million years. Among these dazzling collections, the most distinctive are Shang and Zhou bronzes, pottery figurines of past dynasties, Han and Tang gold and silverware, and Tang tomb murals.

## Shaanxi Ancient Civilization Exhibition (Basic Exhibition) hall, where you can see the

The most well-furnished exhibition hall, where you can see the Terracotta Warriors and Horses

There are three galleries in chronological order, divided into 7 parts: the prehistory period, Zhou Dynasty, Qin Dynasty, Han Dynasty, Wei, Jin, Southern and Northern Dynasties, Sui and Tang Dynasties, and Tang Dynasty and later, showing the ancient history of Shaanxi from the appearance of ancient humans 1.63 million years ago to before 1840. More than 3,000 precious cultural relics such as painted pottery utensils of ancient ancestors, bronze wares of people in Zhou Dynasty terracotta warriors and horses of Qin Dynasty, tiledang of Han Dynasty, gold and silver wares of Tang Dynasty and Tang tri-colored pottery are displayed.

#### Mural Paintings of the Tang Dynasty (Special Exhibition)

Tang tomb murals are a unique and precious collections of Shaanxi History Museum. There are nearly 600 fine murals of more than 20 Tang tombs, covering more than 1,000 square meters, of which 82 of 69 pieces (groups) are rated as first-grade. There are 97 treasures of murals, including pictures of envoys from the tomb of Prince Zhanghuai, pictures of polo, and pictures of hunting trips, pictures of the guard of honor at the tomb of Prince Yide, and pictures of maids in the tomb of Princess Yongtai.

Treasures of the Great Tang Dynasty - Exhibition of Cultural Relics Unearthed in Hejia Village (Special Exhibition)

#### The Most Popular Exhibitions

The hoard built in Tang Dynasty in Hejia Village, Xi'an, was one of the most important archaeological discoveries in the Sui and Tang Dynasties in the 20th century. It was accidentally excavated in 1970, and more than 1,000 cultural relics such as gold and silver utensils, precious jade ornaments, and Chinese and foreign coins were found. Nearly 300 pieces (groups) of precious cultural relics are displayed in the exhibition, among which the agate cup inlaid with gold animal heads, the golden bowl with mandarin duck lotus petal pattern, and the silver pot with gilt dancing horsebit cup pattern are national treasure-level cultural relics.

## The Agate Cup Inlaid with Gold Animal Heads

Treasures of the Great Tang Dynasty - Exhibition of Cultural Relics Unearthed in Hejia Village

A masterpiece of Tang Dynasty carving art, it is carved from a rare multicolored silk agate, and the cup body imitates the shape of animal horns. It witnesses the dining ways of celebrities of Tang Dynasty to worship the style of the northern ethnic tribes and to imitate novelty.



## **Three-Colored Camel Carrying Musicians**

Shaanxi Ancient Civilization Exhibition

There is an eight-member singing band on the camel's back. The craftsmanship is exquisite and the shape is vivid. It is the best of Tang tri-colored potteries

Tang tri-colored pottery is a low-temperature glazed pottery handicraft popular in the Tang Dynasty. It is named after the three colors of green, yellow and white.

Tang Dynasty silverware, made in imitation of the leather pots used by nomads in northern China, is a product of the exchange and fusion of ethnic cultures with those of the Middle Kingdom.

## Mandarin Duck and Lotus Petal Pattern Gold Bowl

Treasures of the Great Tang Dynasty - Exhibition of Cultural Relics Unearthed in Hejia Village

A total of two golden bowls with the same shape and decoration were unearthed in Hejia Village The smooth lotus petals, the stable double structure and the gorgeous decorations are typical of the artistic style of the Tang Dynasty.





## Polo Sports

#### Exhibition of Mural Paintings of the Tang Dynasty

Tang tomb mural, painted on the west wall of the tomb of Prince Zhanghuai in Tang Dynasty, reproduces the scene and style of polo sports in Tang Dynasty in a realistic style.



#### Shaanxi Ancient Civilization Exhibition

The texture of this jade seal is mutton fat jade from Hotan, Xinjiang. The four characters "Huang Hou Zhi Xi", which means the queen's seal, are in seal script on the seal surface. Experts speculate that it is the thing of Lv Zhi, the empress of Emperor Gaozu of the Han Dynasty. It is the only empress jade seal of the Han Dynasty discovered so far.



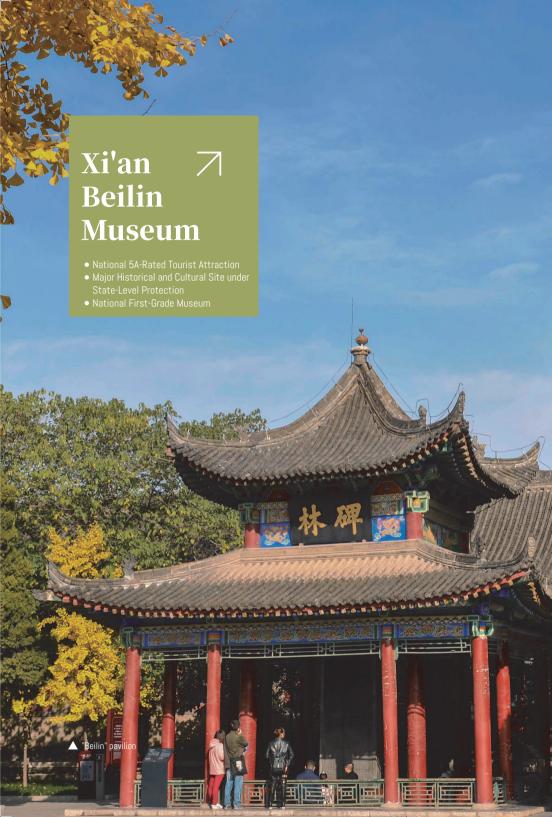


## Bronze Tiger-Shaped Tally of Du County

Shaanxi Ancient Civilization Exhibition

It is a cultural relic of the Warring States Period, and it is the earliest surviving certificate of military deployment in China, and the 40 inscriptions on the tiger talisman are exquisite and beautiful.

It is the prototype of the museum's souvenir "Tiger Symbol Biscuits".







Highlights: calligraphy inscriptions, stone carving art

The Stele Forest in Xi'an which exists 900 years , Has saved the Chinese civilization from the Han Dynasty to the Wei and Jin Dynasties, To Tang, Song, Yuan, Ming and Qing Dynasties, Making it an unbroken thread.

During the Northern Song Dynasty, people moved the "The Book of Filial Piety", "the KaiCheng Stone Classics" and the inscriptions of famous calligraphers, such as Yan Zhenqing and Chu Suiliang, into the Confucius Temple at that time. As the stone tablets are so much that it looks like a forest, people begin to name it the "Beilin" which means Stele Forest.

Xi'an Beilin Museum is a special museum built on the basis of the "Xi'an Stele Forest" with a history of more than 930 years and the expansion of the ancient buildings of the Confucian Temple in Xi'an. And it is known as "The Treasury of the Eastern Culture", "The Palace of Stone Carvings of Han and Tang Dynasty" and "the Oldest Stone Carving Library in the world". The collection of this museum contains more than 10,000 pieces in total, including more than 4,000 pieces of epitaphs on steles, epitaphs, stone statues, portrait stones and other stone-carved cultural relics, as well as other cultural relics such as calligraphy, paintings, and stele rubbings.

#### Xi'an Stele Forest

The Stele Forest in Xi'an is built in the Northern Song Dynasty (1087 A.D.) and has been repaired and built in the Song, Yuan, Ming, Qing Dynasties, and Republic of China. It now houses more than 4,000 stele and epitaphs from the Han Dynasty to the present, with a collection time span of more than 2,000 years. The steles of the past dynasties are mainly collected in the stele pavilion and seven exhibition rooms on the Stele Forest Square, the most important of which is the stele pavilion that displays the "The Filial Piety Sutra of Shitai" and the second exhibition room where the famous steles of the Tang Dynasty are displayed.

#### Xi'an Confucian Temple (Confucian Temple)

The Stele Forest Museum in Xi'an was expanded on the basis of the ancient building complex of the Confucian Temple in Xi'an. Today's Confucius Temple in Xi'an retains the basic scale and iconic buildings of the Confucian Temple complex in the Ming and Qing Dynasties which includes Zhaobi(a screen wall facing the gate of a house), Archway, Lingxing Gate, Ornamental Column, Ji Gate, Stele Pavilion, etc.

#### Xi'an Stone Carving Art Studio

The Xi'an Stone Carving Art Room mainly displays the tomb stone carvings from the Han Dynasty to the Ming and Qing Dynasties. Among them, the Six Steeds of Zhao Mausoleum, the Statue of Laojun, the Li Shou'sStone Coffin of Tang Dynasty and the Epitaph, the Beasts of Eastern Han Dynasty, the Portrait Stones are all fine works of stone carving art in various dynasties.

#### Stone Carving Art Museum

With the theme of "Chang'an Buddhist Rhythm", about 150 stone carvings from the Northern Wei Dynasty to the Song Dynasty are displayed, representing the highest level of Buddhist arts of Chang'an in history. There is a multimedia interactive area in the museum, where visitors can experience Buddhist culture through interaction.

## "The Filial Piety Sutra of Shitai" Treasure of the Museum

Located in the "Stele Forest" pavilion at the central axis of Stele Forest Square

National treasure-level cultural relic, it was engraved in the fourth year of Tempo (A.D. 745). The Confucian classic "The Filial Piety Sutra of Shitai", which was annotated by Li Longji, Emperor Xuanzong of Tangand inscribed by Li Heng, Emperor Suszong of Tang, is known as "the first monument to welcome guests" and it is one of the earliest of the collections to be moved into the Stele Forest

The top line of "The Filial Piety Sutra of Shitai" is read from right to left, and it happens to be three interesting words "I am slightly cute".



## the Six Steeds of Zhao Mausoleum

Exhibited in Xi'an Stone Carving Art Room

A national treasure-level cultural relic, it is engraved in the tenth year of Tang Zhenguan (A.D. 636). The Six Steeds of Zhao Mausoleum are six stone carvings in Zhao Mausoleum. The prototypes are the six horses that Li Shimin, Emperor Taizong of the Tang Dynasty once rode during the founding war of the Tang Dynasty. Among them, "Salu Purple" and "Fun Mao Ping" are replicas, and the real ones have been lost abroad.



There are many cute stray cats living in the Stele Forest. The most popular is "Salu Yellow", whose name is taken from "Salu Purple" in the Six Steeds of Zhao Mausoleum.







## ■ The Kaicheng Shijing

Exhibited in the first exhibition room of the Stele Forest

Tang stone inscriptions, carved in A.D. 837, contains 12 Confucian classics including "Book of Changes", "Shangshu" and "Book of Songs", with a total of more than 650,000 characters. It is regarded as an important document to study the history of Chinese Confucian classics and it is also known as "the Library Made of Stone".

## The Stele of the Preface of Holy Doctrine Written of San Zang the Great Tang Dynasty

Exhibited in the second exhibition room of the Stele Forest

Written by Li Shimin, Emperor Taizong of the Tang Dynasty, the inscription on the stele sings praises to Master Xuanzang, and the calligraphy is the handwriting of Wang Xizhi. It is a stele that connects three great figures in Chinese history, so this stele is called "Three Wonders Steles".







## Jingyun Bell

Located on the east side of Ji Gate

The inscription on the body of the bell was written by Li Dan, Emperor Ruizong himself. This bell was originally hung in Jinglong Temple in Chang'an City in Tang Dynasty. And then it was moved to Xi'an Bell Tower in the early Ming Dynasty to tell the time, and later it was collected in Xi'an Beilin Museum.



Located on the west side of Ji Gate

This stone horse unearthed at the site of Chang'an City in Tang Dynasty in Xi'an is engraved with the era name of the Da Xia Kingdom, which was founded by Huns and lasted only 24 years. And it is the only thing that has characters on it and can prove the existence of the Da Xia Kingdom.

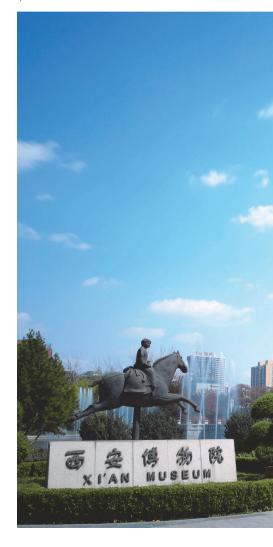


#### Highlights: The history of the ancient capital of Xi'an

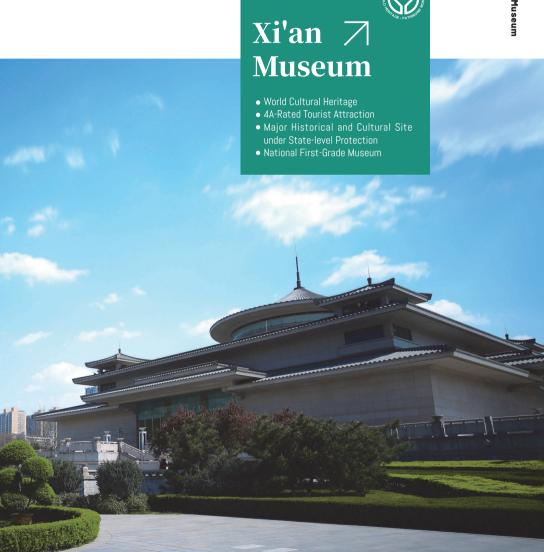
Thirteen dynasties established their capitals in Xi'an,
Countless cultural heritage has been left behind.
Today, a history of several thousand years is concentrated in the Xi'an Museum,
It shows the brilliance and glory of the city.

The Xi'an Museum consists of three parts: the museum, the Site of Tang Jianfu Temple, and the Small Wild Goose Pagoda. It is an urban museum integrating cultural relics collection, scientific research. social education, and garden leisure. The museum has a collection of more than 110,000 cultural relics. including more than 14400 cultural relics above the third national level. and more than 2 000 cultural relics. are displayed in the museum. Among them, precious cultural relics such as the Three-Colored Flying Horse and the Western Zhou Yongyu are the treasures of the museum.

The Small Wild Goose Pagoda is the pagoda of Jianfu Temple, the royal temple of Chang'an City in Tang Dynasty, with a history of more than 1,300 years. In 2014, with the successful application of "Silk Road: Road Network of Chang'an-Tianshan Corridor", the Small Wild Goose Pagoda was included in the "World Heritage List".









With the theme of "Ancient Capital Xi'an", the main line of the museum is the history of the ancient capital Xi'an for more than 1,000 years and the history of urban development for more than 3,000 years. The cultural relics are displayed in the three galleries of "Millennium Ancient Capital", "Emperor Capital Vientiane" and "Magnificent Chapters of the Capital" in the order of the time. The sand table model of Chang'an City, together with a series of precious cultural relics like Yongyu of Western Zhou Dynasty, Gilt Bronze Bell, Noble Ladies Figurines of the Tang Dynasty and the Three Colored Flying Horseshows the imperial style and life group portraits of the ancient capital Xi'an.

#### Thematic Exhibitions

Thematic Exhibitions includes s special display of Buddhist statue art of "Baoxiang Majestic", and a display of ancient jade artifacts in the courtyard of "Spirit of Heaven and Earth". The most famous among the cultural relics is the gilt bronze statue of Dong Qin in the "Bao Xiang Majestic" exhibition hall.

#### Jianfu Temple

The famous royal monastery in Chang'an City of Tang Dynasty was built in 684 A.D. In ancient times, the "Yan Pagoda Morning Bell" that rang every day in the temple was known as one of the eight scenic spots in Chang'an, and now tourists can experience ringing the bell and pray for blessings.

#### Small Wild Goose Pagoda

The Small Wild Goose Pagoda is the Buddhist pagoda of Jianfu Temple. It has a history of more than 1,300 years and still maintains the original appearance when it was first built in the Tang Dynasty. The tower has fifteen floors, and the top two floors have been damaged by the earthquake in the Ming Dynasty. At present, the Small Wild Goose Pagoda has been included in the World Cultural Heritage List.

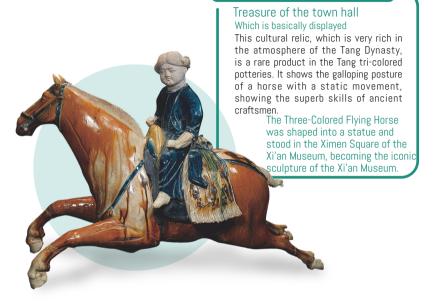

This group of Tang Dynasty pottery figurines have round faces, plump bodies, different postures, and self-confidence, vividly showing the unique temperament of noble women in the Tang Dynasty.







## Gilt Bronze Buddhist Statues Exhibited in the Exhibition Hall of "Bao Xiang Majestic"

A cultural relic of the Sui Dynasty, this statue is centered on Amitabha Buddha, with bodhisattvas, warriors, and squatting lions scattered at different heights. It is the most complicated in structure and the most intact one of those gilt bronze buddha statues.

# Jade Goblet Exhibited in the "Spirit of Heaven and Earth" Exhibition Hall

The Jade Goblet, a cultural relic of the Qin Dynasty, unearthed from the Epang Palace site, is the earliest and only jade cup with tall feet in the Qin Dynasty known so far.





# Jade Dancer Exhibited in the "Spirit of Heaven and Earth" Exhibition Hall

The Jade Dancer, a cultural relic of the Han Dynasty, is the largest round-carved jade dancer with a clear unearthed record so far. It was unearthed in the Mausoleum of Duling, Emperor Xuan of the Han Dynasty, and experts believe that it was used by Emperor Xuan of the Han Dynasty.

# The Permanent Exhibition of Yongyu in the Western Zhou Dynasty

Western Zhou bronzes, with 123-character inscriptions cast inside, have important historical value for studying the Western Zhou land system and the political status of historical figures at that time.





# The Permanent Exhibitions of Shijun's Coffin

Shjjun's Coffin is a cultural relic of the Northern Zhou DynastyThe four-armed patron saints, sacrifices, ascension, feasting, hunting and other relief patterns around the stone coffin have obvious Western styles.

## Permanent Exhibitions of Silver Bowls with Honeysuckle Pattern

A cultural relic of the Tang Dynasty, the shape of the silver bowl is made of the Sogdian gold and silverwares ,and the production process is "beating", and the decorative pattern on the bowl's belly is the local Chinese pattern "Honeysuckle pattern" in the Tang Dynasty.





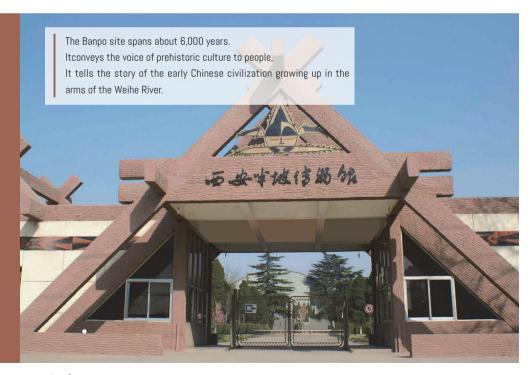
# Xi'an / Banpo Museum

- National 4A-Rated Tourist Attraction
- Major Historical and Cultural Site under State-Level Protection
- National First-Grade Museum

Xi'an Banpo Museum is the first prehistoric tribal settlement sites museum in New China. It was built and opened on the Banpo site in 1958. The Banpo site are the ruins of a matriarchal clan of the Yangshao Culture in the Neolithic Age about 6000 years ago. It was discovered in the spring of 1953. The site covers an area of about 50,000 square meters and unearthed nearly 10,000 production tools and living utensils, as well as a considerable number of painted potteries and sculptures. Other works of arts and various decorations show the developed prehistoric civilization in the Yellow River Basin.

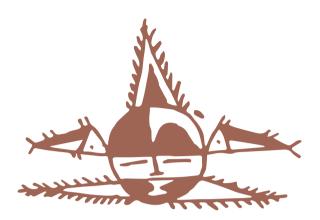
The exhibition area of the museum is about 4,500 square meters, which consists of an exhibition hall of unearthed cultural relics, a heritage protection hall and a temporary exhibition hall. When you are walking into the museum, it seems as if you have traveled through time into the life of the ancestors of Banpo. You can see the scenes of hunting and fishing, raising pigs and planting millets, cooking rice, and building houses. You can also learn about the unique forms of tombs and ancient potteries and painting arts at that time.

#### Exhibition Hall of Unearthed Cultural Relics

The exhibition hall is divided into 5 units: "The Cyan Riverside", "Poems of Life", "Pastoral Songs", "Spiritual Charm" and "Hidden Mysteries". It displays the stone tools, potteries, bone tools and other cultural relics unearthed from the Banpo site, as well as some production tools, living utensils and works of art used by the primitive ancestors, so that we can understand the production and living conditions of the ancestors.

#### Heritage Conservation Hall

A part of the original village is preserved in the Heritage Conservation Hall, covering an area of about 3,000 square meters. It consists three parts: living zone, pottery zone and tombs zone, from where you can see the ruins of semi-crypt style houses, pottery kiln, and cemetery at that time. It vividly shows the appearance of primitive villages in Banpo period, reflecting the production level of Banpo people and the social nature and system at that time.

The painted pottery pot with human face and fish pattern is the most precious national first-grade cultural relic unearthed from the Banpo Site, and it is now collected in the National Museum of China.

## Red Pottery Human Head Pot, "living fossil" of Yangshao Culture

The human head pot is made of red pottery. The combination of the human head and the pot body resembles a pregnant woman. The corners of the mouth of the woman rise slightly, revealing a mysterious smile. Archaeologists believe that the shape of the pot was modeled after a pregnant woman to express the greatness of maternal love.





## Jomon Terracotta Ampoule Vase

The sharp-bottomed bottle is one of the typical artifacts of the Yangshao Culture, and it is the most commonly used water-drawing device for the Banpo people. Its shape features are: small mouth, bulging belly, ears, pointed bottom. This wonderful device that automatically draws water fully reflects the wisdom and wisdom of Banpo people.

# Painted Pottery Pot with Five Fish Pattern

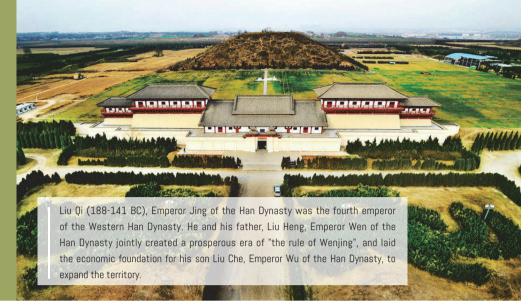
The fish pattern is the characteristic of the early Banpo type of Yangshao Culture. The inner bottom of the pot is like a miniature pool landscape, with five fish chasing and playing counterclockwise, and the picture is very vivid.





## Painted Pottery Pot with Polka Dot Hook and Leaf Pattern

The Yangshao Culture Miaodigou type is famous for its exquisite painted pottery patterns. The pots are made of clay yellow pottery, with abstract geometric patterns such as dots, hook leaves, arc-edge triangles, etc. painted on the abdomen.

## Highlights: Cultural Relics of the Han Dynasty, Museum of Underground Ruins

The Hanyang Mausoleum is the joint burial cemetery of Liu Qi, Emperor Jing of the Han Dynasty and his empress Wang. And it is the most intact mausoleum of emperors in the Han Dynasty excavated so far. About 100,000 cultural relics such as warrior figurines, lady figurines, and animal figurines were unearthed in more than 200 burial pits in the mausoleum area.

The museum has four permanent exhibitions: the archaeological exhibition hall, the protection exhibition hall of the outer pit of the emperor's mausoleum, the exhibition hall of the Nanque Gate ruins, and the Site of the ancestral temple. After more than 2,000 years of staying underground, the Han Dynasty pottery figurines are still gorgeous and lifelike, showing the superb craftsmanship of Western Han craftsman.



## Tour Guide

#### Archaeological Gallery

With the theme of "A Mighty Grand Scene", nearly 1,000 cultural relics are displayed in three chapters. The first chapter introduces Emperor Jing of the Han Dynasty concept of governing the country, his historical contributions, and the planning and construction of the Hanyang Mausoleum; the second chapter displays the archaeological unearthed cultural relics of the past 30 years, fully demonstrating the material culture, political system and spiritual life of the Han Dynasty; the third chapter presents the concept of heritage conservation of the Hanyang Mausoleum. There are many multimedia interactive experience areas in the museum.

#### Protection Exhibition Hall of the Outer Tibetan Pit of the Emperor's Mausoleum

The best tour experience: walk on the glass to visit the Site and cultural relics under your feet

This exhibition hall is an all-underground building built on 10 outer pits in the northeast of the emperor's mausoleum. It is the first all-underground site museum in the world built with advanced cultural relics protection technology. Visitors can walk on the glass to view the relics of more than 2,000 years ago in a mysterious environment. The exhibition hall also uses phantom imaging technology to interpret historical stories and reproduce the court life of the emperors of the Western Han Dynasty.

#### Nangue Gate Site

Nanque Gate is the south gate of Emperor Mausoleum City and it is the earliest and the highest in rank and the largest ruins of the mausoleums of the emperors. The appearance of the exhibition hall is an imitation of a Han-style building. On the basis of protection, the majestic and tall buildings of the "San Chu Que" towers are displayed to tourists. The exhibition hall mainly introduces the development and evolutionary history of ancient Chinese tower buildings.

#### The Palace Temple Site

The Palace Temple Site is the most well-preserved imperial mausoleum temple architectural site found so far. It is regular in shape and large in scale, and it is comparable to the ritual architecture of Chang'an City in the Han Dynasty. The museum partially restored the site and moved it horizontally, and greened it in a large area, showing the grandeur of the architecture of the ancestral temple in the Western Han Dynasty.

# Suyi Style Painted Sitting Maid Figurines

The maid figurines of Hanyang Mausoleum are thin in shape, with slender shoulders and slender waists. They are wearing smiles on their faces. They are completely different from the graceful, luxurious, plump figurines of the figurines of the ladies of the Tang Dynasty. Their gestures show the graceful beauty of ancient Chinese women.





## Zhuoyi Style Painted Female Figurines/Armored Warrior Figurines

The pottery figurines were originally equipped with movable wooden arms and wore clothing or armor. However, due to the deep burial for a very long time, the clothes were decayed and the wooden arms turned to ashes, making them come to the world with their arms lost.

## Dancing Figurines

The right arm of the dancing figurine is raised like a sleeve on the shoulder, and the left arm is slightly lowered like a long sleeve stretched. The wonderful dance is frozen in a moment, showing the superb sculpture skills of the craftsmen of the Han Dynasty.





## Painted Pottery Chicken

A large number of pottery animal figurines such as pottery horses, pottery chickens, pottery pigs, etc. were unearthed in the Hanyang Mausoleum, reflecting the prosperity of the six animals in the period of Emperor Jing of the Han Dynasty.

# The Earliest Tea Specimen in the World

The ancient tea leaves more than 2,100 years ago were unearthed in the Hanyang Mausoleum, which was certified as "the oldest tea in the world" by the Guinness Book of World Records.





# Xi'an Tang / West Market Museum

The West Market was once the most prosperous international trade center in Chang'an, the capital of Tang Dynasty. The Tang West Market Museum, built on the "West Market Site", is the first non-state-owned National First-Grad Museum China, with a collection of more than 20,000 cultural relics. The cultural relics unearthed in the West City mainly reflect the Silk Road trade in the Tang Dynasty and the life of the Tang people in the market.

## Sea Beast Grape Pattern Mirror

The sea beast grape pattern is one of the most attractive patterns in the bronze mirrors of the Tang Dynasty. It was mainly popular during the Tang Gaozong and Wu Zetian periods.



## Painted Hu People Riding Camel Figurines

This figurine is tall in shape and meticulous in craftsmanship. And it is regarded as one of the best among the series of the figurines riding a camel of the Tang Dynasty.

## Three-colored Bird Male Figurine

The figurine is glazed all over, with bright colors and a leisurely and unrestrained image. The hilarious demeanor when flirting with birds is fully reflected.



## Hunting Silver Jar with Lid

The whole body of the jar is decorated with creeping grass, birds, beasts, and hunting figures on horseback. It is a rare artistic masterpiece of the Tang Dynasty.

# Baoji / Bronze Ware Museum

- National 4A-Rated Tourist Attraction

Baoji is known as the "Hometown of Chinese Bronze Wares". From the Shi Chen Tripodunearthed in the Western Han Dynasty to the four national treasures in the late Qing Dynasty - Maogong Tripod, Da Yu Tripod, Sanshi Plate and Guojizi White Plate. The number of bronze ware unearthed in Baoji area has reached 20 thousand pieces.

## Highlights: Bronze wares in the Shang and Zhou dynasties

Baoji Bronze Ware Museum is located in Shi-ku Garden, a National 4A-Rated Tourist Attraction. It is the first bronze cultural museum named after bronze ware in China. Now it has become a landmark building in Baoii.

The architectural shape of the museum adopts the architectural language of high platform gates and bronze thick soil, which is magnificent and majestic. The exhibition hall covers an area of 11,000 square meters, and the cultural relic restoration and protection laboratory is 500 square meters. It has more than 480,000 cultural relics, including 3,245 precious cultural relics, of which t more than 1,500 bronzes form Shang and Zhou dynasties are the most famous

#### Permanent Exhibitions

The first exhibition hall "Hometown of Bronze Ware": 260 bronze utensils unearthed in Baoji are displayed, which are divided into 4 parts: Yangjia Village Cultural Relics Exhibition Area, Other Bronze Wares Cultural Relics Exhibition Area of Baoji, Bronze Ware Hometown Thematic Exhibition Area and Origin Tracing Of the Zhou Dynasty Section. The hall is displaying the prosperity of the bronze wares of Baoji.

The second exhibition hall, "State of Zhou Rites": It takes Zhou rituals as the main line, and begins with the bronze tree symbolizing the Zhou people's patriarchal system and it displays 688 pieces of cultural relics such as Hugui of Emperor Li, Qiang Basin and He Zun.a ritual wine vessel etc.

The third exhibition hall "Road to Empire": Taking the decline and eastward migration of the Zhou royal family and the rise of the Qin Empire as clues, there are 360 cultural relics, focusing on the Duke of Oin.

The fourth exhibition hall "Light of Wisdom": 160 cultural relics are displayed, focusing on the animal world of bronze wares and the national treasure Zhe Gong, which means an animal-like bronze cup. Visitors can learn about the unique artistic charm of bronze ware and experience the complete craftsmanship of bronze ware production.

#### Thematic Exhibitions

There are three Thematic Exhibitions: "Ancient Bronze Mirrors and Fashion Life Exhibition", "Ancient Ceramics and Cultural Life Exhibition", and "Ancient Jade Ware and Art Life Exhibition".

## He Zun The treasure of the museum

## Displayed in the Second Exhibition Hall

He Zun is a bronze ware of the Western Zhou Dynasty and it is the first batch of national treasure-level cultural relics in China that are prohibited from going abroad (territorial) for exhibition. There are 122 inscriptions cast on the inner bottom of the statue, which record the important historical facts of Emperor Cheng's five years (1038 BC) moving his house in the 5th year of Emperor Cheng. There is the earliest written record of the word "China" in the inscription.







## **Qiang Basin**

Displayed in the Second Exhibition Hall

The Qiang Basin is a piece of Western Zhou bronzeware. The inscriptions on the plate are based on the ancestors of the eight generations of the Shan family, and it is interspersed with the twelve emperors of the Western Zhou Dynasty, which confirms the names of the kings of the Western Zhou Dynasty in the "Historical Records", making it of high historical value.



## Displayed in the Second Exhibition Hall

Weighing 60 kilograms, the Hu Gui is the largest bronze gui in the Shang and Zhou dynasties discovered so far, and is known as the "King Gui". The inscription is a sacrificial inscription for Jihu, Emperor Li of the Zhou Dynasty to worship the ancestors and pray for the blessings of the gods.

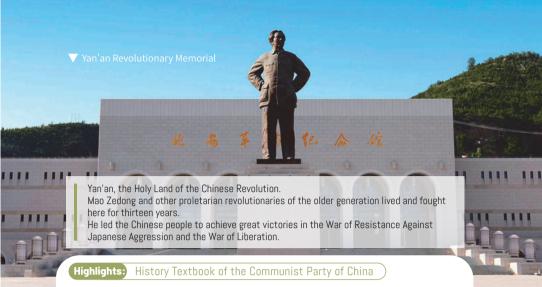




## Qin Duke Bo

## Displayed in the Thrid Exhibition Hall

Qin Duke Bo is a piece of bronze ware during the Spring and Autumn Period. It is used in conjunction with the Duke of Qin's bell as a sacrificial musical instrument for the ancestral temple of the Duke of Qin. A total of three pieces were unearthed, and each of the three has a single inscription of 135 characters, which recorded the lineages of the ancestors of the Qin state, Duke Wen, Duke Jing, Duke Xian, Duke Qin, and the five generations of the Qin Dynasty. The Qin Duke Bo is of high historical value.



# Yan'an / Revolutionary Memorial Hall

- National 5A-Rated Tourist Attraction
- National First-Grade Museum

Founded in 1950, the Yan'an Revolutionary Memorial Hall is located on the east bank of the Yanhe River in Yan'an. It is one of the earliest revolutionary memorial built after the founding of New China. In 2009, the new Yan'an Revolutionary Memorial was completed, with a permanent exhibition area of more than 10,000 square meters and a collection of more than 36,000 cultural relics.

The Memorial mainly publicizes the glorious history of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China in Yan'an for thirteen years, and has played an important role in carrying forward the revolutionary tradition, carrying forward the spirit of Yan'an, and inheriting the red gene. It has been listed as the first batch of national patriotism education demonstration bases, the national red tourism classic scenic spots, the first batch of national Anti-Japanese war memorial facilities site, and the first batch of national primary and middle second-grade school students' research and practice education bases.

# **Orange** Tour Guide

#### Permanent Exhibitions

With the theme of "The Great History - Thirteen Years of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China in Yan'an", it consists of seven parts, displaying 2,021 precious cultural relics (groups) and more than 900 photos. The exhibition includes 26 artwork scenes including the victory of the Red Army's Long March to Northern Shaanxi (sculpture) and the Mass Production, as well as multimedia interactive exhibits such as the Battle of Zhiluo Town displayed with 3D naked-eye technology.

#### Thematic Exhibitions

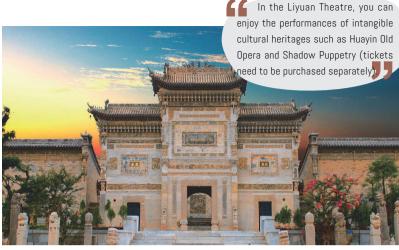

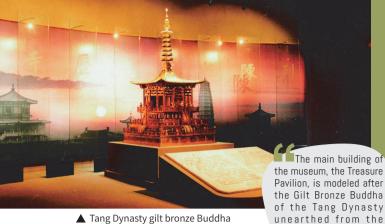

# Wuzhangyuan Zhuge Liang Temple Museum

During the Three Kingdoms period, Zhuge Liang stationed troops in Wuzhangyuan to confront Sima Yi, and later died of illness in Wuzhangyuan due to overwork. In order to commemorate Zhuge Liang, people built the Zhuge Liang Temple here facing the north and the Wei River, symbolizing Zhuge Liang's lifelong desire to pursue the Northern Expedition and to achieve national unity. 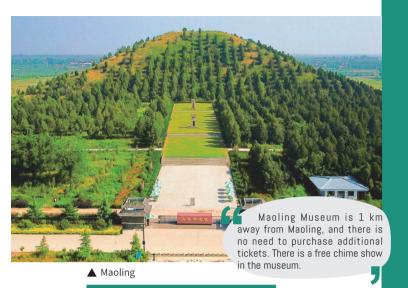

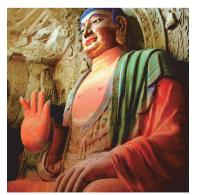

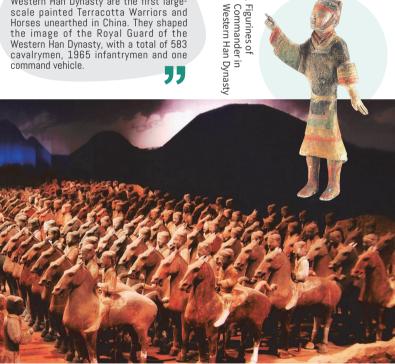

The Three Thousand Painted Terracotta Warriors and Horses in the Western Han Dynasty are the first largescale painted Terracotta Warriors and Horses unearthed in China. They shaped the image of the Royal Guard of the Western Han Dynasty, with a total of 583 cavalrymen, 1965 infantrymen and one command vehicle.

The site of the Xianyang Museum is the Ming Dynasty Confucian Temple, a Major Historical and Cultural Site under State-level Protection, with a collection of more than 20.000 cultural relics, it mainly includes the exhibitions of historical relics of Xianyang in the Oin Dynasty, Yangijawan3.000 painted terracotta warriors of the Western Han Dynasty, Xianyang steles, Buddhist cultural relics, and Ancient Ferry Site. Mian County Wuhou Shrine is a sacrificial temple to commemorate Zhuge Liang, an outstanding statesman, military strategist and Prime Minister of Shu of the Three Kingdoms in Chinese history. Built in A.D. 263, the memorial temple is the earliest and the only one that is built under the direct order of an emperor (Liu Shan, the second Emperor of the Shu of the Three Kingdoms). That's the reason why it enjoys the high reputation of "the Top among Zhuge Liang's Memorial Halls". There are 91 inscriptions on steles and 62 plagues in various eras since the Han Dynasty, and 65 other cultural relics collected in the museum and 35 ancient and famous trees are still in the scenic spot.

#### ▲ Xunyang County Museum

There is a thousand-year-old ancient cypress in the northwest corner of the middle courtyard. Next to the ancient cypress, there is a stele of Ming Dynasty, which is engraved with the "Revisiting Confucianism Stele" by Chen Shilong, the magistrate of Xunyang County in the Ming Dynasty. The stele, together with the cypress, is called "The Shadow of the Cypress and the Bronze Stele".

The Xunyang County Museum is located in the old town of Xunyang, where the Han River and the Xun River meet. The museum site is the Confucian Temple of the Ming Dynasty in Xunyang. There are more than 10,000 cultural relics in the collection, including stone tools and pottery of the Neolithic period, as well as copper, iron, porcelain, jade, stone and bone tools of various historical periods, especially the cultural relics of the Qin and Han Dynasties of the Warring States Period. Fengyan Ancient Terraces is the first open immigrant eco-museum in China. It is the largest and best-preserved terraced fields in the Qing Dynasty that has been discovered by archaeological discoveries in Qinba Mountains. It is more than 250 years old. And it is known as the "living specimen" of the reclaim of Southern Shaanxi by immigrants from Hunan, Hubei and Guangdong Province and the "living fossil" of Chinese farming culture. There are 12,000 mu of ancient terraced fields reclaimed by the Wu family who migrated from Hunan in the Qing Dynasty to the local area, as well as more than 20 well-preserved ancient residential courtyards and more than 20 ancient villages and castles. In March, rapes are in full bloom, and in May, the terraces are irrigated and transplanted, and the sea of clouds in the early morning after the rain begin to gather. They are the most beautiful time of terraced fields.

Sima Qian is also known as the "Sage of History" because of the "Records of the Grand Historian".



Sima Qian Temple is a memorial tomb built to commemorate Sima Qian, a famous Chinese historian. It was built in A.D. 310 and is located on a cliff 10 kilometers south of Hancheng. It is a Major Historical and Cultural Site under state-level protection. The buildings of the ancestral tombs are built on the cliff, and the layers go up. There are many steles in the temple, which are chanted by famous people of all dynasties. Behind the temple is the tomb of Sima Qian, which is shaped like a yurt. Legend has it that it was built by Kublai Khan, the ancestor of the Yuan Dynasty. "Gone with the wind, the Record of History written by Sima Qian still haunts Hancheng City."
